Good Faith Effort Plan (GFEP) FAQs

Q: Is the 20% SMWB goal mandatory?

A: No, but we ask prime contractors to do their best with good faith outreach efforts. If the goal is not met, proof of outreach efforts is required with the submittal.

- Q:What if I am having trouble finding SMWB subcontractors?
 - A: Please email the SMWVB Program Manager with the scopes of work you are seeking. You will receive lists of local SMWVB-certified firms to contact.
- Q:What if my business is SMWB-certified? Do I need to find SMWB subs?
 - A: If your firm is SMWVB-certified, you will most likely meet the goal. However, the GFEP is a required document, and a good faith outreach effort is still necessary.
- Q: Do I need to include all my subcontractors in the GFEP or just those that qualify towards the SMWB goal?
 - A: All subcontractors need to be included in the GFEP, even those that may not count towards the SMWB goal.
- Q:What if I have questions about the GFEP?

Contract Requirements

Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis
- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
- Site visits are random and unannounced
- Interviews will be Conducted and will be private & confidential
- Payroll records are subject to review
- All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting
- Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
- Late payrolls delay contractor payments from SAWS



Contract Requirements

- Insurance requirements are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs
 - Builder's Risk is replaced by Installation Floater (see Supplemental Conditions)
 - Maintain insurance coverage during the construction of this Project
- Compliant prior to executing the contract
- Will ask for insurance prior to Board award to expedite execution of the contract



Bid Packet Preparation

- Utilize the Bid Packet Checklist within the specifications
- Statement of Bidder's Experience be completed and included by all Bidders
- Company information packet, statement regarding ability to complete the project, W-9, Baseline Schedule, and Project Manager and Superintendent resumes also to be included by all Bidders
- Double check all mathematical calculations and verify all extensions
- Be aware of the Mobilization and Preparing Right-Of-Way maximums
- References and contact information must be <u>verified</u> prior to submitting Addendums are now acknowledged on the Bid Proposals

Contract Requirements

Supplemental Conditions

- Contractor shall perform the work with its own organization on at least 40% of the total original contract price to be confirmed by the Bidder on page I of the Good Faith Effort Plan.
- Bidder is required to submit Statement of Bidders Experience as part of their bid.
- For the purpose of preparing the baseline schedule, all Respondents shall assume a notice to proceed date of December 12, 2019



 - > UXO





Special Conditions

Access and Coordination Requirements

- > JBSA Ft Sam Houston Contractor will need to comply with security procedures and obtain long term base access pass for all employees, subcontractors, and suppliers that may be working/visiting site.
- ➤ Fort Sam Houston Golf Course SAWS is in process of obtaining temporary construction easements through golf course and for contractor laydown area. Anticipate to be available prior to NTP.

Work Restrictions

- > No work on federal holidays.
- Tree removals and tree pruning must be completed outside of migratory bird breeding season which runs from March I-Aug I5.
- > Active nests (nest containing birds and/or eggs) should be avoided.



Special Conditions

Unexploded Ordinance Requirements

- Portions of this project lie within an area of JBSA-FSH that has potential to contain unexploded ordinance (UXO).
- Contractor shall inform and train all employees on UXO procedures and guidelines when working in these areas.
- Contractor shall contact the Base Civil Engineer 24-hr service call number immediately if an item is encountered that may be UXO at 210-671-5555.
- > UXO handouts are provided in Appendix D of this document.

Staking of Temporary Construction Easements:

- The Contractor shall stake the edges of the Temporary Construction Easements and Permanent Easement.
- Easement documents attached in the Appendix of Contract Documents.



Special Conditions

Permits:

- Contractor responsible for obtaining Dig Permit from JBSA-FSH.
- > SAWS is obtaining Floodplain Development Permit from City of San Antonio.
- Contractor to follow City of San Antonio Tree Guidelines contained in coordination memo (to be issued in Addendum).
- Contractor is responsible for all other required permits per the General Conditions.



Special Provisions to Technical Specifications

- Item 100 Mobilization
 - > Intermediate Demobilization/Remobilization
- Item 101 Preparing Right-of-Way
 - > 20-foot temporary easements shall be staked at 50-foot intervals and all deflection points.
 - > Coordinate with Ft. Sam Houston Golf Course to schedule staking work
- Item 516 Sodding
 - > Tifway 419 Bermuda Sodding restoration required in Golf Course Fairways.



Special Provisions to Technical Specifications

- Item 855 Reconstruction of Existing Manholes
 - > Specific manholes located inside the floodplain shall be vented as indicated on plans and vent configuration detail as per the plans (NSPI)
- Item 901- Rehab of Sanitary Sewer by CIPP
 - > Water Inversion and Cure. Revisions to description, submittal, and construction sections.
- Item 1103 Point Repairs and Obstruction Removals
 - > Changes to obstruction removals. No separate pay item for hanging gaskets and fine root removals.



Special Provisions to Technical Specifications

- Item 1109 Sanitary Sewer Laterals, Stub Outs or Reconnections
 - > Sanitary service reconnection to be done by a combination of remote and excavation methods.
 - Inserta-Tees required for permanent lateral connections after CIPP of main is completed.

Special Specification

- Item SP 4000 Composite Construction Matting
 - > Composite construction matting will be required in areas of golf course as indicated on plans.
 - Measured and paid on square yard basis
 - > Shall include all required equipment, materials and labor to install, maintain, and remove the composite construction matting
