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Good Faith Effort Plan (GFEP) FAQs

• Q: Is the 20% SMWB goal mandatory?

A: No, but we ask prime contractors to do their best with good faith outreach efforts. If the goal is not met, proof of outreach efforts is required with the submittal.

• Q:What if I am having trouble finding SMWB subcontractors?

A: Please email the SMWB Program Manager with the scopes of work you are seeking. You will receive lists of local SMWB-certified firms to contact.

- Q:What if my business is SMWB-certified? Do I need to find SMWB subs?
 A: If your firm is SMWB-certified, you will most likely meet the goal. However, the GFEP is a required document, and a good faith outreach effort is still necessary.
- Q: Do I need to include all my subcontractors in the GFEP or just those that qualify towards the SMWB goal?

A: All subcontractors need to be included in the GFEP, even those that may not count towards the SMWB goal.




Key Reminders

- Late bids will not be accepted, and will be returned unopened
- Due to the COVID-19 emergency and to protect the health of the public, SAWS is implementing new procedures for the submission of bids
- Bids will be received either Electronically or through Sealed bids
- Electronic bids will be received via the secure SAWS FTP site

Bid Packet Preparation

- Utilize the Bid Packet Checklist within the specifications
 - All items due with the bid
- Double check all mathematical calculations and verify all extensions
- Addendums are acknowledged on the Bid Proposals
- Ensure Mobilization & Prep ROW Line Item does not exceed the percentage allowed
- References and contact information must be verified prior to submitting bid(s)
- A Baseline Schedule should be part of the Bid Packet with an assumed NTP date of December 21,2020.

Contract Requirements

Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis
- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
- Site visits are random and unannounced
- Interviews will be Conducted and will be private & confidential
- Payroll records are subject to review
- All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting
- Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
- Late payrolls delay contractor payments from SAWS

Contract Requirements

- Insurance requirements are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs
 - Installation Floater and Pollution Liability is required for all projects
 - Maintain insurance coverage during the construction of all projects
- Compliant prior to executing the contract
- Will ask for insurance prior to Board award to expedite execution of the contract
 - Any deficiencies must be corrected prior to Board award



 - Approximately 1,360 LF Open Cut Method
 - Approximately 2,675 LF Trenchless Method (680 LF± Installed through an existing casing, crossing Loop 1604)
 - Rehabilitate Existing Manhole
 - Bypass Pump

Contract Requirements – Special Conditions

Key Special Conditions

- SC2 Permits
 - SAWS will obtain Utility Installation Request/ROW permits from TxDOT in accordance with the Contract Documents
 - Contractor is responsible for obtaining CoSA ROW and street cut permits
- SC3 Project Related Investigations
 - The existing sewer casing crossing Highway Loop 1604 has been televised by SAWS and the video is available for viewing upon request
- SC5 Traffic Control Plan
 - A traffic control plan is included in the Contract Documents. Any proposed modifications to the traffic control plan shall be prepared by a professional engineer licensed in the State of Texas and submitted to SAWS and to CoSA for approval
 - No additional payment or time extension will be granted for TCP modifications proposed by the Contractor



Contract Requirements – Special Conditions (Cont.)

Key Special Conditions

- SC7 Artisan at Judson Park
 - Work in the vicinity of the entrance shall be kept neat and orderly at all times
 - Area adjacent to the entrance shall not be used for stockpiling or storage
 - Access to the property shall not be blocked at any time
- SCII CPS Energy Allowance
 - This item shall be an allowance for any fees from CPS Energy associated with the electrical improvements for the Judson Rd. Water Infrastructure Improvements Lift Station
 - Payment of this item shall be a reimbursement to the Contractor for the CPS Energy fees
 - Reimbursement amount shall be the actual fees incurred associated with the project scope
 - Contractor shall provide receipts from CPS Energy to SAWS for reimbursement
