## Good Faith Effort Plan (GFEP) FAQs

#### • Q: Is the 20% SMWB goal mandatory?

A: No, but we ask prime contractors to do their best with good faith outreach efforts. If the goal is not met, proof of outreach efforts is required with the submittal.

• Q:What if I am having trouble finding SMWB subcontractors?

A: Please email the SMWB Program Manager with the scopes of work you are seeking. You will receive lists of local SMWB-certified firms to contact.

- Q:What if my business is SMWB-certified? Do I need to find SMWB subs?

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



- Double check all mathematical calculations and verify all extensions
- Addendums are acknowledged on the Bid Proposals
- Ensure Mobilization Line Item does not exceed the percentage allowed
- References and contact information must be verified prior to submitting bid(s)
- A Baseline Schedule should be part of the Bid Packet with an assumed NTP date of May 17, 2021

### **Contract Requirements**

Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis
- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
- Site visits are random and unannounced
- Interviews will be Conducted and will be private & confidential
- Payroll records are subject to review

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- All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting
- Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
- Late payrolls delay contractor payments from SAWS

## **Contract Requirements**

- Insurance requirements are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs
  - -Pollution Liability & Installation Floater is required
  - -Maintain insurance coverage during the construction of this Project
- Compliant prior to executing the contract
- Will ask for insurance prior to Board award to expedite execution of the contract

#### Project Details

- The motors to be replaced are located in the Steven M Clouse WRC compressor building which is equipped with a crane for motor removal
- The compressor building can be used as a construction staging area so long as stored equipment does not block building ingress/egress and does not cause a violation of the NEC working space around electrical equipment
- The motor bases were constructed for the existing motors. If the new motors are <u>dimensionally different than the existing motors</u>, <u>base adjustments</u> will be required to ensure that the motor is properly supported and motor shaft is in correct alignment with the existing blower
- Low voltage cable/conduit for motor space heaters and motor protection will need to be replaced if the existing cable/conduit is too short to allow termination in the motor terminal boxes
