Due to the COVID-19 emergency and to protect the health of the public, SAWS is implementing new procedures for the submission of bids. Bids will be received either Electronically or through Sealed bids, until 1:00 PM (CDT), November 12, 2021. Electronic bids will be received via the secure SAWS FTP site. Sealed bids will be received by Contract Administration, 2800 U.S. Hwy 281 North, Tower II, Customer Center Building, via a drop box located on the left wall when walking through the first set of double glass doors of the main Tower II entry on the north side of the building, San Antonio, Texas 78212. See the Electronic Bid Opening Instructions attachment for additional information regarding an electronic bid submittal. Electronic bids shall be accompanied by a bid bond in an amount not less than five percent of the total bid price. (Or, if providing SAWS with a cashier's check or certified check in an amount not less than five percent of the total bid price, SAWS will request this within 24 hours from the apparent low bidder. Sealed bids must be accompanied by a cashier's check, certified check, or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent of the total bid price. Bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud by Contract Administration via WebEx.

If Bidders intend to submit bids electronically, Bidders will need to submit a request by <u>November 11, 2021</u> at 1:00 PM (CDT) to receive access to the File Transfer Protocol (FTP) site via email to <u>Stella.Manzello@saws.org</u>. FTP BID PROPOSAL UPLOAD

In order to receive electronic bids for this project, SAWS will utilize a SAWS secured File Transfer Protocol (FTP) site. Only Bidders bidding as Prime Contractors will need to submit their request prior to November 11, 2021 at 1:00 PM (CDT) to receive access to the FTP site via email to Stella.Manzello@saws.org. Bidder's email shall provide the legal name of the Bidder's company and the intended recipient's email address and phone number. No requests for FTP site access will be accepted after November 11, 2021 at 1:00 PM (CDT). Once a Bidder is approved for access, an email with a hyperlink to the FTP site and a unique password for the Bidder will be provided to the Bidder's email recipient.

Once access is received, Bidders may upload the required documents per the Bid Proposal checklist any time before November 12, 2021 at 1:00 PM (CDT). Please ensure to allow sufficient time should Bidder's experience technical difficulties in uploading the required documents. No changes to the Bid nor bid price can be made once the Bid has been submitted.

Bidders shall comply with the following:

- 1) Limit files to one (1) pdf file that includes all requested documents, per the Bid Packet Checklist. ONLY ONE SUBMITTAL WILL BE ACCEPTED PER REQUEST. Do not upload any zip files.
- 2) Ensure that the itemized List of Bid Items is (are) the first page(s) of your file.
- 3) Bidders may protect the document from editing by adding a password. However, the document must be accessible for viewing by SAWS without requiring a password.

- 5) DO NOT SHARE ACCESS AND/OR PASSWORD WITH OTHER PARTIES OUTSIDE YOUR COMPANY.

- Interested firms/contractors must RSVP to Stella Manzello via email at <u>Stella.Manzello@saws.org</u> to attend the site visit no later than <u>October 21, 2021 at 1:00 p.m.</u> The following information should be provided:
 - o Company name
 - Name(s) of attendees
 - There is a limit of two (2) members per firm/contractor.
 - o Request for a site visit time on October 22, 2021.
- All parties must adhere to SAWS' COVID-19 Safety Procedures.
- The site visit duration is expected to be no more than 1 hours combined, excluding the drive time.
- There are to be **no** Q&A during the site visit, but contractors/firms may take videos, photos, and notes.
- Questions shall be submitted to Stella Manzello in writing via email to at Stella.Manzello@saws.org.
- Questions will be addressed as required through addendum.

Procedures to follow if you plan to attend the site visit:

- Site visit will begin at the Stephen M. Clouse (SMC) WRC. Arrive at the SMC WRC Guard Shack located at 3495 Valley Rd, San Antonio, TX 78221 15 minutes prior to the site visit time.
- The firm/contractor will be provide the contact cell number to enter the facility and drive to where the screening kiosk is located.
- Temperature screenings will be conducted for all attendees.
 - o If attendee has a temperature reading of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or less, a wrist band will be provided.
 - o If attendee exhibits a temperature above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, the individual will not be allowed on the site visit.
- A mask and safety eyewear must be worn at all times by all attendees. Safety mask must cover mouth and nose at all times.
- Following the temperature screening, attendees shall proceed for their scheduled site visit.
- Attendees must maintain social distancing, minimum of 6-feet apart, from other attendees at all times.
- All attendees shall review the SAWS safety mask guidelines attached.
- Attendees will be escorted by SAWS personnel at all times, and should not stray.

As COVID-19 continues to spread within the United States, CDC has recommended additional measures to prevent the spread of SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19. In the context of community transmission, CDC recommends that you:



Stay at home as much as possible



Practice social distancing (remaining at least 6 feet away from others)



Clean your hands often



In addition, CDC also recommends that everyone wear cloth face coverings when leaving their homes, regardless of whether they have fever or symptoms of COVID-19. This is because of evidence that people with COVID-19 can spread the disease, even when they don't have any symptoms. Cloth face coverings should not be placed on young children under age 2, anyone who has trouble breathing, or is unconscious, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance.

How cloth face coverings work

Cloth face coverings may prevent the person wearing the mask from spreading respiratory droplets when talking, sneezing, or coughing. If everyone wears a cloth face covering when out in public, such as going to the grocery store, the risk of exposure to SARS-CoV-2 can be reduced for the community. Since people may spread the virus before symptoms start, or even if people never have symptoms, wearing a cloth face covering may protect others around you. Face coverings worn by others may protect you from getting the virus from people carrying the virus.



General considerations for the use of cloth face coverings

When using a cloth face covering, make sure:

- · The mouth and nose are fully covered
- The covering fits snugly against the sides of the face so there are no gaps
- You do not have any difficulty breathing while wearing the cloth face covering
- The cloth face covering can be tied or otherwise secured to prevent slipping



Wash your cloth face covering after each use in the washing machine or by hand using a bleach solution Allow it to completely dry.
