

Good Faith Effort Plan (GFEP) FAQs

- Q: Is the 20% aspirational SMWB goal mandatory?
 - A: No, but we ask prime contractors to do their best with good faith outreach efforts. If the goal is not met, proof of outreach efforts is required with the submittal.
- Q:What if I am having trouble finding SMWB subcontractors?
 - A: Please email the SMWVB Program Manager with the scopes of work you are seeking. You will receive lists of local SMWVB-certified firms to contact.
- Q:What if my business is SMWB-certified? Do I need to find SMWB subs?
 - A: If your firm is SMWVB-certified, you will most likely meet the goal. However, the GFEP is a required document, and a good faith outreach effort is still necessary.
- Q: Do I need to include all my subcontractors in the GFEP or just those that qualify towards the SMWB goal?
 - A: All subcontractors need to be included in the GFEP, even those that may not count towards the SMWB goal.



Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Payroll records are subject to review
- Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis
- Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
- Late payrolls delay contractor payments from SAWS
- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Site visits are random and unannounced
- Interviews will be conducted and will be private & confidential
- All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting



Supplemental Conditions

- Insurance requirements are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs
 - Installation Floater in lieu of Builder's Risk
 - Maintain insurance coverage during the construction of this Project
- Will ask for insurance prior to Board award to expedite execution of the contract
- All contracts with SAWS must be compliant prior to executing the contract for this project

 Statement of Bidder's Experience
 - Four (4) projects completed between 2016 2021
 - A-I demonstrates rehabilitation of a min. of 3,000 LF by CIPP for sanitary sewer mains 36-in +
 - A-2 demonstrates rehabilitation of a min. of 3,000 LF by CIPP for sanitary sewer mains 48-in +
 - A-3 demonstrates rehabilitation of a min. of 3,000 LF by CIPP for sanitary sewer mains 60-in +
 - A-4 demonstrates a sanitary sewer bypass pumping system w/peak flow rate of 50 MGD capacity +
 - A-I and A-2 shall be separate projects
 - A-3 may be the same as one of the projects provided for in A-1 or A-2 or a separate project
 - A-4 may be the same as A-1,A-2 or A-3
 - A-I, A-2 and A-3 must have been completed by the Bidder
 - A-4 is to have been completed by the Bidder (if Bidder is self-performing bypass pumping) or the Bidder's Bypass Subcontractor



Supplemental Conditions (Continued)

• Contractor shall perform the work with its own organization on at least 40% of the total original contract price which should be indicated on the Good Faith Effort Plan.

Liquidated damages will be assessed at \$1,557.00 per day



Bid Packet Preparation

- Utilize the Bid Packet Checklist within the specifications
- Double check all mathematical calculations and verify all extensions
- Ensure Mobilization and Preparing Right-Of-Way do not exceed percentage, excluding the allowance.
- Addendums are acknowledged on the Bid Proposals
 - Check our website regularly for addendum postings
 - It is possible to have multiple addendums during the time frame in addition to the scheduled final addendum
 - Known Addenda are in response to questions

- Bids will be submitted using SAWS' temporary bid opening procedures
- SAWS encourages and prefers the submission of electronic bids using its secure FTP site.
 - Bidders should submit a request via email to obtain access to the site no later than 24 hours before the bid opening.
- Or, Bidders may drop off bid; but only the required items
 - Drop box is located at 2800 US Hwy 281 N, Customer Service Tower
 - Enter the first set of glass double doors
 - Insert into the black drop box on the wall on the left hand side
- Late bids will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.



 - Shoring shall support existing 42" recycled water line bedding and backfill
- Item 851:Adjusting Existing Manholes
 - Shall also include venting of lids
- Item 853: Sanitary Sewer Glass-Fiber Reinforced Polyester (FRP) Manholes
 - Includes FRP manhole riser, concrete grade beam and precast concrete lid, and concrete encasement
- Item 854: Sanitary Sewer Laterals
 - Cleanouts to be paid per each installed and includes pipe, fittings, bedding, trenching, and backfill
- Item 855: Reconstruction of Existing Manholes
 - Covers the replacement of siphon structure lids
 - Interior coating of siphon structures to be paid for separately




Special Provisions to Technical Specifications

- Item 901: Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewer By Cured-In-Place Pipe
 - Hot water inversion only, no steam curing
 - Hydrophilic End Seals required at each end of the pipe segment
- Item 1103: Point Repairs and Obstruction Removals
 - Hanging gaskets are subsidiary to Item 868
 - Obstruction Removals shall be paid per each pipe segment


- Item 910: Manhole Rehabilitation
 - Includes siphon structure specific rehabilitation
 - Independent coating inspector is required for siphon structures – to be added via addendum
 - Three types of siphon structure repair modifications
- Item 951: Cast-In-Place Concrete
- Item 952: Repair and Rehabilitation of Cast-In-Place Concrete
- Item 953: Precast Structural Concrete Vaults
