2. What is the time frame for this project?

The anticipated notice to proceed for this project is June 20, 2022. The total contract duration is 300 days, and the elevated storage tank cannot be taken out of service until September 17, 2022.

CHANGES TO SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. Due to an update in the General Wage Decision for Building Construction Type, remove the building wage decision document from the solicitation in entirety and replace with the revised version attached (rev. 02/25/2022, General Decision Number TX20220231). This version should be utilized by the awarded contractor for the project.
- 2. Due to an update in the General Wage Decision for Heavy and Highway Type, remove the heavy and highway wage decision document from the solicitation in entirety and replace with the revised version attached (rev. 02/25/2022, General Decision Number TX20220007). This version should be utilized by the awarded contractor for the project.

3. Amend Page SIR-8, Supplementary Instructions to Respondents as follows:

- a. In Paragraph 3.b.i, replace "May 20, 2022" with "June 20, 2022."
- 4. Amend Page SC-1, Special Conditions as follows:
 - a. Add the following sentence to the end of SC2. Construction Phasing and Sequencing:
 - The elevated storage tank must not be taken out of service for rehabilitation work until September 17, 2022.
- 5. Amend Specification 11550 Fall Prevention and Safety Systems as follows:
 - a. Replace Paragraph 2.03.C with the following:
 - Provide laser engraved "POE Sample Tap" on 8" x 10" stainless steel plate at sample taps.

6. Amend Specification 16640 Cathodic Protection as follows:

a. In the first sentence of the second Paragraph of section 2.01.C, replace "Section 4.2.4.1.1 Type A, Horizontal System." with "Section 4.2.4.2.2, Vertical System."

The body of each wage determination lists the classification and wage rates that have been found to be prevailing for the cited type(s) of construction in the area covered by the wage determination. The classifications are listed in alphabetical order of ""identifiers"" that indicate whether the particular rate is a union rate (current union negotiated rate for local), a survey rate (weighted average rate) or a union average rate (weighted union average rate).

Union Rate Identifiers

A four letter classification abbreviation identifier enclosed in dotted lines beginning with characters other than ""SU"" or ""UAVG"" denotes that the union classification and rate were prevailing for that classification in the survey. Example: PLUM0198-005 07/01/2014. PLUM is an abbreviation identifier of the union which prevailed in the survey for this classification, which in this example would be Plumbers. 0198 indicates the local union number or district council number where applicable, i.e., Plumbers Local 0198. The next number, 005 in the example, is an internal number used in processing the wage determination. 07/01/2014 is the effective date of the most current negotiated rate, which in this example is July 1, 2014.

Union prevailing wage rates are updated to reflect all rate changes in the collective bargaining agreement (CBA) governing this classification and rate.

Survey Rate Identifiers

Classifications listed under the ""SU"" identifier indicate that no one rate prevailed for this classification in the survey and the published rate is derived by computing a weighted average rate based on all the rates reported in the survey for that classification. As this weighted average rate includes all rates reported in the survey, it may include both union and non-union rates. Example: SULA2012-007 5/13/2014. SU indicates the rates are survey rates based on a weighted average calculation of rates and are not majority rates. LA indicates the State of Louisiana. 2012 is the year of survey on which these classifications and rates are based. The next number, 007 in the example, is an internal number used in producing the wage determination. 5/13/2014 indicates the survey completion date for the classifications and rates under that identifier.

Survey wage rates are not updated and remain in effect until a new survey is conducted.

Union Average Rate Identifiers

Classification(s) listed under the UAVG identifier indicate that no single majority rate prevailed for those classifications; however, 100% of the data reported for the classifications was union data. EXAMPLE: UAVG-OH-0010 08/29/2014. UAVG indicates that the rate is a weighted union average rate. OH indicates the state. The next number, 0010 in the example, is an internal number used in producing the wage determination. 08/29/2014 indicates the survey completion date for the classifications and rates under that identifier.

A UAVG rate will be updated once a year, usually in January of each year, to reflect a weighted average of the current negotiated/CBA rate of the union locals from which the rate is based.

WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:
