## **Contract Requirements**

- Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards Section
   2.10 of the General Conditions
  - Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis
  - Wage decisions are included within the specifications
  - Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
  - Site visits are random and unannounced
  - Interviews will be Conducted and will be private & confidential
  - Payroll records are subject to review
  - All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting
  - Interviews will be Conducted and will be private & confidential
  - Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
  - Late payrolls delay contractor payments from SAWS



## **Contract Requirements**

#### Supplemental Conditions

- Contractor shall perform the work with its own organization on at least 40% of the total original contract price.
- Liquidated Damages in this contract, will be assessed on a daily basis. Any days tallied after 42 days will be assessed at the tier 6 rate.

### **Contract Background**

**Scope:** Bid for construction is for a specified contract with approximately 3,066 LF of 8" to 33" Cured in Place Pipe (CIPP) for the 2017 EARZ CIPP Construction Contract, SAWS Job No. 17-4536

- This project is part of the Consent Decree
- Bypass pumping option is included in the design.
- Contractor to become familiar with specs and site.
- TCP routes are included in the design.

- SAWS will obtain TxDOT/Arborist/TCEQ/UPRR permits as required
- Contractor to secure other ROW permits
- Construction schedules will be part of the bid
- Change orders if any will be based on negotiated prices not in bid proposal.
- There will be one pre-construction meeting;
   Materials submittals will be required at the pre-construction meeting.
- Sites located within the EARZ, secondary containment requirements apply



## **Contract Background**

#### **Bidder Experience:**

- minimum of 3 successfully *completed* sewer projects located in the USA using Cured in Place Pipe (CIPP) method with 8"-33" diameters
- Installing Contractor must have been actively involved in the direct field installation of the exact brand-name product proposed, for a minimum of five years at the time of bid.
- Projects with no defaults, completed within the contract time & incurred zero owner claims.

- Prior commencing work and due 7-days after the pre-construction meeting, contractor must submit and receive approval of the following:
  - Bypass plan
  - Traffic control plan
  - Initial Construction Schedule
  - Pre-site video
  - Lease agreement
- Construction staking, cut sheets, SW3P, and CoSA ROW permits will be responsibility of contractor at no cost to SAWS.
- SAWS will obtain only tree preservation permits, SCS and TXDOT permits.
- Contractor must submit a Work Progress
   Schedule within 10 days of NTP and monthly thereafter



## **Contract Background**


- Changes in field cited by a City Inspector require concurrence and approval from SAWS inspector first.
- If contractor wants to work weekends, notification is required 48 hrs. in advance to SAWS Construction Inspections. Requests should be send to <u>constworkreq@saws.org</u>
- For all projects requiring the use of pipe plugs the Contractor shall furnish a submittal containing manufacturer's product data, instructions, recommendations and a project Plug Use Plan (PUP). The PUP shall be submitted a minimum of two weeks prior to commencing any portion of the proposed scope of work. Monitoring shall be for 24-hours per day during the plug use duration.
