Oral statements or discussion during the pre-bid meeting will not be binding, nor will it change or affect the terms or conditions within the Plans and Specifications for this Project. Changes, if any, will be addressed only via an Addendum.

Project Overview

- Purpose of the project is to decommission Lift Station 224 and replace it with a 12-inch PVC gravity sewer main.
- Approximately 3,000 LF of PVC pipe.
- Average depth of excavation 12 ft.
- Decommissioning & removal of existing lift station.

Pre-Bid Meeting

- Non-mandatory pre-bid meeting
- Attendees should sign-in and sign-in sheet will be posted on SAWS website
- Key project information:
 - Construction duration is 180 calendar days
 - Construction estimate is \$1,960,975.00
 - Construction services being procured through IFB
 - Geotechnical Data Report with boring logs is available on SAWS website for this project upon completing of a disclaimer form

Contract Requirements

- Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards Section 2.10 of the General Conditions
 - Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis
 - Wage decisions are included within the specifications
 - Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
 - Site visits are random and unannounced
 - Interviews will be conducted and will be private & confidential
 - Payroll records are subject to review
 - All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting
 - Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
 - Late payrolls delay contractor payments from SAWS



Contract Requirements (Continued)

- Insurance requirements are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs
 - Builder's Risk is waived and replace by Installation Floater coverage (see Supplemental Conditions)
 - Maintain insurance coverage during the construction of this Project
- Submittals and invoicing will be handled through CPMS

Required Experience

- Contractor shall have experience constructing sewer mains 12inch or larger.
- Detailed requirements are included in the Statement of Bidder's Experience, which must be completed by the contractor.


Bid Packet Preparation

- References and contact information should be verified prior to submitting a Bid
- Addendums are acknowledged on the Bid Proposals Signature Page



 - Work must be phased so newpipe can be installed throughlocation of existing wet well



Contract Requirements – Special Provisions

Key Special Provisions

- Item 100 Mobilization: Establishes Intermediate Demobilization and Remobilization bid item if elected by SAWS.
- Item 804 Excavation, Trenching, and Backfill: Maximum length of open trench is limited to 400 LF.
- Item 852 Sanitary Sewer Manholes: Revision to maximum distance from top of cone to ring and cover (max 4 throat rings).
- Item 856 Jacking, Boring or Tunneling Pipe: Added grouting of annular space between casing pipe and carrier pipe.

Contract Requirements – Special Specifications

Special Specifications

- Item 545 Temporary Construction Fence: Defines temporary construction fence to separate construction activities as shown.
- Item 1005 Lift Station Decommissioning: Describes details regarding lift station decommissioning & demolition requirements.
- Item I 120 Existing Utility Potholes: Defines requirements for Contractor potholing of existing utilities.
