

#### Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis
- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
- Site visits are random and unannounced
- Interviews will be conducted and will be private & confidential
- Payroll records are subject to review
- All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting
- Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
- Late payrolls delay contractor payments from SAWS



### Contract Requirements

Insurance—Section 5.7 of the General Conditions

#### **Insurance Requirements**

- Construction with Pollution, Installation Floater and XS 2
- Compliant prior to executing the contract
- Selected contractor must be compliant with all other contracts in order for SAWS to award the contract
- Will ask for insurance prior to Board award to expedite execution of the contract
  - Any deficiencies must be corrected prior to Board award





- Liquidated Damages (\$1,475.00 per day)
- Tree Mitigation/Protection Plans
- Sequence of Work
  - Construction phasing plan and detour plan


## Project Background

- There have been several main breaks in this area due to pipe deterioration







### Project Details

#### **Coordination:**

- Contractor shall coordinate and notify all local Hospitals and Businesses of any required shut down prior to disrupting any water services
  - Must maintain service to Hospital during Tie In with work on each side of Division Valve carefully coordinated
  - Must maintain Service to Dialysis Clinic (no service interruption)



### Project Details

#### **Coordination (Continued)**

- At Tie Ins, ensure Hot Tap will be used to minimize disruption to existing systems, ensure shoring is used to preserve existing pavement sections
- Contractor to contact VIA Metropolitan Transit one week prior to construction and as required to coordinate bus stop relocations.
- Coordinate with SAWS inspector regarding working hours and proposed service shutdowns for tie-ins
