Good Faith Effort Plan (GFEP) FAQs

Q: Is the 20% SMWVB goal mandatory?

A: No, but we ask prime consultants to do their best with good faith outreach efforts. If the goal is not met, proof of outreach efforts is required with the submittal.

Q:What if I am having trouble finding SMWVB subconsultants?

A: Please email the SMVVB Program Manager with the scopes of work you are seeking. You will receive lists of local SMVVB-certified firms to contact.

Q:What if my business is SMWVB-certified? Do I need to find SMWVB subs?

A: If your firm is SMWVB-certified, you will most likely meet the goal. However, the GFEP is a required document, and a good faith outreach effort is still necessary.

Contract Requirements

Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis
- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
- Payroll records are subject to review
- All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting
- Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
- Late payrolls delay contractor payments from SAWS



Contract Requirements

- Insurance requirements are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs
 - Construction w/ Pollution, Builders Risk & XS 2
 - Maintain insurance coverage during the construction of this Project
- Compliant prior to executing the contract
- Will ask for insurance prior to Board award to expedite execution of the contract

Bid Packet Preparation

- Utilize the Bid Packet Checklist within the specifications
- Statement of Bidder's Experience to be completed and included by all Bidders
 - Statement of Bidder's Experience Form includes: Project manager and superintendent resumes detailing work experience and references to include 3 similar projects, general project experience, and specific project experience
 - Detailed Baseline Schedule is required
 - Company information packer to include W-9
 - Statement regarding ability to complete project



Bid Packet Preparation

- Double check all mathematical calculations
- Be aware of the allowances provided
- Be aware of the following line items (in Bid Proposal):
 - Line 17 Intermediate Demob and Remob, shall not be more than 10% of the subtotal of line items 1-16
 - Line 18 Mob and Prep of ROW, shall not be more than 10% of the subtotal of line items 1-16
 - Line item 19 Prep of ROW, shall not be more than 1% of the subtotal of line items 1-16
- References and contact information must be <u>verified</u> prior to submitting,
 Addendums are now acknowledged on the Bid Proposals




