General Information

• Sealed bids are requested for the construction of approximately 1,794 linear feet (LF). This project involves the construction of water improvements on Dixie Lee Road from just south Mogford Road to Martha Road that is predominantly single family residential to include an 8-inch water line extension along Dixie Lee Road, approximately 1,794 LF of water main.

Good Faith Effort Plan (GFEP) FAQs

Q: Is the 20% SMWB goal mandatory?

A: No, but we ask prime contractors to do their best with good faith outreach efforts. If the goal is not met, proof of outreach efforts is required with the submittal.

Q:What if I am having trouble finding SMWB subcontractors?

A: Outreach lists from the South Central Texas Regional Certification Agency are now Excel-exportable at www.sctrca.sctrca.org. If you are having trouble with the downloads, please email the SMWB Program Manager.

Q:What if my business is SMWB-certified? Do I need to find SMWB subs?

A: If your firm is SMWB-certified, you will most likely meet the goal. However, the GFEP is a required document, and a good faith outreach effort is still necessary.

• Q: Do I need to include all my subcontractors in the GFEP or just those that qualify towards the SMWB goal?

A: All subcontractors need to be included in the GFEP, even those that may not count towards the SMWB goal.

Contract Requirements

Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis including weeks in which work is not performed by noting such
- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Contractors (and their subcontractors) shall utilize LCP Tracker
 - Site visits by SAWS staff are random and unannounced
 - Interviews will be Conducted and will be private & confidential
 - Payroll records are subject to review
 - All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting
 - The Prime Contractor is responsible for sub-contractor payroll
 - Late payrolls may delay contractor payments, as well as release of retainage



Contract Requirements

- Insurance requirements for this project are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs
 - Pollution, Installation Floater is required in lieu of Builder's Risk, and
 Professional Liability (Errors & Omissions) \$2M per claim
- Contractor must maintain insurance coverage during term of construction of this Project
- Contractor's insurance must be compliant on all SAWS project, including this one, prior to executing the contract
- SAWS will ask for insurance prior to Board award to expedite execution of the contract
 - Any deficiencies must be corrected prior to Board award



Contract Requirements

- The Contractor shall perform the Work with its own organization on at least 40% of the total original contract price to be confirmed by inserting the percentage performed by the Bidder on page 1 of the Good Faith Effort Plan.
- Liquidated Damages are \$824 per day.



Bid Packet Preparation

- Utilize the Bid Packet Checklist within the specifications
 - Only limited items are required with the initial bid packet
- **Double check** all mathematical calculations and verify all extensions
- Addendums are acknowledged on the Bid Proposals
- Ensure Mobilization & Prep ROW Line Item does not exceed the percentage allowed
- References and contact information must be verified prior to submitting bid(s)
- Within one day of bid opening the apparent Low Bidder shall submit the following:
 - Conflict of Interest Questionnaire, Proof of Insurability (Letter from Insurer or Sample Certificate
 of Insurance), Company Information Packet, Statement Regarding Ability to Complete the Project,
 W-9, Baseline Schedule with an assumed NTP date of January 2, 2023

Bid Packet Preparation (cont.)

- Bidder shall ensure that the 3 projects submitted on the Statement of Bidder's Experience forms are:
 - Contain open cut work of comparable size and scope <u>as indicated on the check boxes</u>
 - Completed within the last 5 years
 - Owner references (entity bidder contracted with)
 - Verifiable with up-to-date contact information for the Owner reference provided
- Failure to complete the form properly may result in the bid being found non-responsive.

- Sealed bids will be received by Contract Administration, 2800 U.S. Hwy 281 North, Tower II, Customer Center Building, via a black drop box located on the left wall when walking through the first set of double glass doors of the main Tower II entry on the north side of the building.
- If bids will be delivered in person, Bidders should allow sufficient travel time.
- Late bids will not be accepted and will not be opened (and returned).

- CPS Energy Power Pole bracing will be reimbursed through an allowance as quantified in Bid Tab
 - Contractor to coordinate pole bracing with CPS Energy and SAWS Inspector
- Contractor's Bid Packet Checklist
 - Statement of Bidder's Experience must be submitted with bid
- Submittals can be turned in as soon as receiving notification of contract award and after
 CPMS training (if necessary) has been completed



General Information

- Mobilization and Prep ROW are separate pay items per package
 - Not to exceed 15% combined (10% Mob, 5% ROW)
- Prep ROW includes clearing and grubbing, tree pruning, tree protection
 - The contractor is to remove any trees in ROW
- Project to be constructed
 - Per SAWS 2021 Construction Specifications
 - Bexar County Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction (Latest Edition)
 - July 2022 update to Spec 840 for water tie-ins





DIXIE LEE WATER LINE EXTENSION




Project Details

- Existing Utilities
 - Overhead electric, AT&T underground cable, no sewer, no gas, 2-inch PVC water tie-in
 - All water service lines shall be field verified prior to construction.
- Services
 - 6 new unmetered ³/₄" water services
 - Sandy Loam Soils
 - Services will be encased in 3" PVC conduit for erosion protection.
- Fire Hydrants
 - 5 new fire hydrants
- Trench Restoration
 - I 0" of Flexible Base
 - TxDOT DMS 6200 Filter Fabric for retaining soil separation.



Project Details

- Dixie Lee and Martha Drive Intersection
 - 2-inch PVC water tie-in must be completed with minimal disruption to the residents.
 - 750 SY of flexible base to the limits shown.
- Trees
 - Contractor to prune, trim or remove any trees in the public ROW as necessary.
- Traffic Control
 - Contractor shall keep half of the road open to the traffic and driveway access during construction.


