Good Faith Effort Plan (GFEP) FAQs

Q: Is the 19% SMWB goal mandatory?

A: No, but we ask prime contractors to do their best with good faith outreach efforts. If the goal is not met, proof of outreach efforts is required with the submittal.

A: All subcontractors need to be included in the GFEP, even those that may not count towards the SMWB goal.

Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis beginning on the start date indicated on the Notice to Proceed, even in non-performing weeks
- Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
- Late payrolls delay contractor payments, as well as release of retainage at the end of the project
- Payroll records are subject to review
- Site visits are random and unannounced
- Interviews will be conducted and will be private & confidential
- All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting work



- Insurance requirements are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs
 - Construction w/ Pollution and Installation Floater is required in lieu of Builder's Risk
- Contractor's insurance must be compliant on all other SAWS projects
- SAWS will request insurance certificate prior to Board award to ensure insurance compliance and to assist in expediting execution of the contract
- Contractor must ensure insurance is compliant for the duration of the contract

Bid Packet Preparation

- Utilize the Bid Packet Checklist within the specifications
- Double check all mathematical calculations and verify all extensions
- Ensure Mobilization & Prep ROW Line Item does not exceed the percentage allowed
- Addendums are acknowledged on the Bid Proposal
 - Check the SAWS website regularly for addendum postings
 - It is possible to have multiple addendums



Bid Opening Procedures

- Bids will be submitted using SAWS' electronic bid opening procedures
- Submission of electronic bids preferred using SAWS secure FTP site.
 - Submit a request via email at least 24 hours before bid opening
- Or, Bidders may drop off a hard copy bid. Only required items.
 - Drop box is located at 2800 US Hwy 281 N, Customer Service Tower
 - Enter the first set of glass double doors
 - Insert into the black drop box on the wall on the left-hand side
- Late bids will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.
- Bid Opening will be handled via WebEx only; link found in IFB



Project Overview

- Project is part of the work required by San Antonio's agreement with the EPA to rehabilitate deteriorated sewer infrastructure across the city.
- Install approximately 1,130 feet of 8" sewer mains and re-route the sewer services via Open Cut method.
- 8-inch clay sewer main abandonment.
- Mistletoe and Woodlawn between Flores and Ripley





Project Details

- Installation of approximately 1,130 feet of 8" PVC pipe
- New services to all affected
- Relocation of private service lines for 19 residences
- Mill and overlay in specific areas of the affected streets
- Replacement of curbs, sidewalks, and driveways affected by construction
- Replacement of sod affected by construction







Construction Phasing


- Project to be constructed in several phases
- Traffic control plans to be implemented for each phase
- Each phase includes sewer main installation along with service re-routing
- Contractor cannot move to next phase until the previous phase is complete





Pavement Restoration


- Pavement repair will be confirmed with CoSA inspector
- Traffic control plans will be in effect to direct traffic during repaving
- Pavement will be done on half the street at a time so as not to inconvenience residents
- Streets will be fully paved within 2-3 weeks weather permitting
- Driveways will be as noted (primarily concrete, but includes gravel and brick)





Customer Service Relocation

- Relocate the existing sewer services from the backyards to the street in front of the property
- Install new yard piping within private property (performed by a Licensed Plumber)
- Final alignment and construction method to be coordinated during construction
- Signed forms needed to allow contractor onto private property

• All work performed shall be in accordance with the current Contract Documents and SAWS Specifications for Water and Sanitary Sewer Construction (2021 Specifications).

Permits and Coordination Requirements

- CoSA ROW Permits will be required and will be the responsibility of the Contractor to obtain. COSA ROW requires 30 days to review the contractor permits.
- The Traffic Control Plan (TCP) has suggested routes only. The Contractor may provide an alternative Traffic Control Plan for approval by CoSA. The TCP must be signed, sealed, and dated by a Professional Engineer licensed in the state of Texas and submitted for approval at least two weeks prior to installation. The TCP must be coordinated with the Bypass Pumping Plan approved by SAWS.
