

 - Bexar, Comal, Guadalupe, Hays, Kendall, Travis, and Williamson counties

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Good Faith Effort Plan (GFEP) FAQs

• Q: Is the 22% SMWB goal mandatory?

A: No, but we ask prime contractors to do their best with good faith outreach efforts. If the goal is not met, proof of outreach efforts is required with the submittal.

• Q:What if I am having trouble finding SMWB subcontractors?

A:The SCTRCA has a search portal at <u>www.sctrca.org</u>. Please make sure to include SAWS-specific parameters in your search. Contact Marisol Robles at <u>Marisol.Robles@saws.org</u> if assistance is needed.

- Q:What if my business is SMWB-certified? Do I need to find SMWB subs?
 A: If your firm is SMWB-certified, you will most likely meet the goal. However, the GFEP is a required document, and a good faith outreach effort is still necessary.
- Q: Do I need to include all my subcontractors in the GFEP or just those that qualify towards the SMWB goal?

A:All subcontractors need to be included in the GFEP, including non-SMWBs.

Contract Requirements

Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis beginning on the start date indicated on the Notice to Proceed, even in non-performing weeks
- Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
- Late payrolls delay contractor payments, as well as release of retainage at the end of the project
- Payroll records are subject to review
- Site visits are random and unannounced
- Interviews will be conducted and will be private & confidential
- All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting work

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Contract Requirements

- Insurance requirements are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs
 - Include Construction with Pollution Coverage
 - Include Installation Floater

- Contractor's insurance must be compliant on all other SAWS projects
- SAWS will request insurance certificate prior to Board award to ensure insurance compliance and to assist in expediting execution of the contract
- Contractor must ensure insurance is compliant for the duration of the contract

Contract Requirements

Supplemental Conditions

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 Contractor shall perform the work with its own organization on at least 40% of the total original contract price which should be indicated on the Good Faith Effort Plan.

- Only limited items are required with the initial bid packet

 - Bid Packet Checklist

 - Bid Bond*
 - Good Faith Effort Plan

Apparent Low Bidder

- Notified by SAWS within 24 hours of Bid Opening to provide the following:
 - Conflict of Interest Questionnaire Form CIQ
 - Proof of Insurability
 - Company Information Packet
 - Statement regarding ability to complete the project
 - W-9
 - Statement of Bidder's Experience
 - Detailed Baseline Schedule
 - *And, if bid was submitted electronically without a Bid Bond:
 - Cashier's Check or Certified Check



- Utilize the Bid Packet Checklist within the specifications
- Double check all mathematical calculations and verify all extensions
- Addendums are acknowledged on the Bid Proposal
 - Check the SAWS website regularly for addendum postings
 - It is possible to have multiple addendums
 - Known changes for addendums:
 - Questions and Answers

Statement of Bidders Experience

- Lowest Bidder shall ensure that the three (3) contracts submitted on the Statement of Bidder's Experience forms:
 - A-litems are completed by the Prime Contractor between 2018-2023
 - Construction of a minimum of 1,000 LF by CIPP construction for sanitary sewer mains 8-inches or larger.
 - Demonstrates the experience to work and coordinate project within TxDOT ROW.
 - Contract A-I shall be different than Contract A-2.
 - A-2 items are completed by the Prime Contractor between 2018-2023
 - Construction of a minimum of 1,000 LF by CIPP construction for sanitary sewer mains 21-inches or larger.
 - Contract A-2 shall be different than Contract A-1.
 - A-3 items are completed by the Prime Contractor or Sub Contractor 2018-2023
 - Construction of a minimum of 100 LF by Open Cut installation method for sanitary sewer mains 21-inches or larger.
 - Contract A-3 may be the same as Contract A-1 or A-2 if project meets all the experience requirements listed.





Statement of Bidders Experience (cont.)

- Verified up-to-date contact information for the Owner references
 - Provide a current phone number and valid email address
- Failure to complete the form properly may result in the bid being found non-responsive





Bid Opening Procedures

- Bids will be submitted using SAWS' electronic bid opening procedures
- Submission of electronic bids preferred using SAWS secure FTP site.
 - Submit a request via email at least 24 hours before bid opening
- Or, Bidders may drop off a hard copy bid. Only required items.
 - Drop box is located at 2800 US Hwy 281 N, Customer Service Tower
 - Enter the first set of glass double doors
 - Insert into the black drop box on the wall on the left-hand side
- Late bids will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.
- Bid Opening will be handled via WebEx only; link found in IFB



- Pipe shows tuberculation & encrustation.





- Rehabilitate approximately 207 LF of 12"DI sanitary sewer main, installed in 1994, by CIPP.
- Pipe shows tuberculation & encrustation.
- Coordination w/ TxDOT will be required.






Project Details (Site 05 – IH-35 Access Road)

- Rehabilitate approximately 400 LF of 8"CP sanitary sewer main, installed in 1968, by CIPP.
- Pipe shows multiple defects and will require point repairs.
- There are multiple utilities in the area.
- Pipe material changes (CP-CI-CP). •
- Contractor to coordinate w/ Motel Studio 6 and Westcore for driveway closure.



Project Details (Site 07 – Probandt St)

- Rehabilitate approximately 439 LF of 12"CI sanitary sewer main, installed in 1964, by CIPP.
- CCTV shows heavy tuberculation and encrustation.
- Contractor shall submit special requirements to clean pipe under highway.
- Coordination w/TxDOT will be required.

Project Details (Site 08 – Somerset)

- Rehabilitate approximately 183 LF of 16"CI sanitary sewer main, installed in 1978, by CIPP.
- CCTV shows heavy tuberculation and encrustation.
- Coordination w/TxDOT will be required.



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
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Project Details (Site 09 – IH-35 @ FSH)


- Rehabilitate approximately 750 LF of 21"VCP sanitary sewer main, installed in 1952, by CIPP.
- Abandon & Grout approximately 397 LF of 20" CI located parallel to sanitary sewer main to be rehabilitated.
- Perform point repair located near the upstream manhole (Coordination w/ FSH will be required).
- Coordination w/ TxDOT will be required.
- UPRR (permit approved) and FSH (coordination pending) coordination required for BPP.
- CCTV shows sanitary sewer main w/ multiple defects and deposits along the pipe.





Project Details (Site 10 – Rosillo Creek)

- Rehabilitate approximately 345 LF of 24"CI sanitary sewer main by CIPP.
- Contractor to coordinate with property owner (Lone Star Truck) for site access and bypass alignment in advance. Temporary construction easements have been acquired. Contractor shall take caution with the high voltage fence.
- Contractor to notify Flint Hills Resources before construction starts. See Special Notes on plans.
- Coordination w/TxDOT will be required.
- Contractor to perform large BPP.





Special Conditions

Project Milestones

- Site 7 Probandt shall be prioritized by the contractor, contractor shall place this site as the first site to be rehabilitate for this sewer package.
- Site 9 Fort Sam Houston shall be scheduled as the last segment to be rehabilitated for this sewer project.

Changes to the Project Scope

- SAWS reserves the right to remove any of the "Project Sites" from the 2020 CMOM Package 6 (Major Roads). If SAWS decides to remove one or more of the "Project Sites" from this package, SAWS will only compensate the contractor for the items previously authorized by the engineer or inspector for the specific "Project Site."
- POINT REPAIRS: The point repairs shown on the plans were based upon previous CCTV obtained during the design phase of the 2020 CMOM Package 6 (Major Roads). The condition of the sewer mains may have changed since the original CCTV. The contractor is responsible to perform their own CCTV of the sanitary sewer mains and submit to SAWS for review and approval before starting construction. SAWS reserves the right to remove or add point repairs as necessary. If SAWS decides to eliminate any point repairs and pertinent items or any other items from the contract, the contractor will only be compensated for the items previously authorized by SAWS.
