## REVISIONS TO CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

## SUPPLEMENTARY INSTRUCTIONS TO RESPONDENTS

a) Page SIR-3, sub-bullet one (1) under bullet three (3) of C.1.a.vii., delete the following paragraph in its entirety:

If Respondent is organized as a corporation, partnership, LLP, LLC or joint venture, submit complete financial statements, including a Balance Sheet, Income Statement and Statement of Cash Flows, prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, for the current fiscal year-to-date, and the most recent three complete fiscal years. Footnote disclosures must accompany the submitted year to date financial statements. If available, financial statements audited or certified by an independent certified public accountant should be submitted; otherwise, a notarized statement certifying the accuracy of the financial information and signed by an officer of the proposing entity must accompany the financial information. If any entity has been in existence less than three (3) years, the information shall be provided for the period of existence.

## And replace with:

If Respondent is organized as a corporation, partnership, LLP, LLC or joint venture, submit complete financial statements, including a Balance Sheet, Income Statement and Statement of Cash Flows, prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, for the most recent three complete fiscal years. Footnote disclosures must accompany the submitted year to date financial statements. If available, financial statements audited or certified by an independent certified public accountant should be submitted; otherwise, a notarized statement certifying the accuracy of the financial information and signed by an officer of the proposing entity must accompany the financial information. If any entity has been in existence less than three (3) years, the information shall be provided for the period of existence.

## SUPPLEMENTARY CONDITIONS

a) Article V CONTRACT RESPONSIBILITIES, Subsection 5.18 Working Hours, delete the following paragraph in its entirety:

Cornerstone Church (Reach 3 and 4) – Work may be done 24/7 except that no work shall be done in the expanded temporary easement from midnight Friday to midnight Sunday. All activity between midnight Friday and midnight Sunday must be contained within the reduced limits of the temporary construction easement as shown on the drawings. No material delivery, equipment delivery or hauling will be allowed from midnight Friday to midnight Sunday. Access will be allowed for work trucks only. Contractor shall move all temporary barriers (e.g. chain link fence, New Jersey Barriers, etc) and all equipment, materials, or miscellaneous items form the expanded temporary construction easement limits to the reduced temporary easement limits no later than midnight every Friday and no earlier than midnight on Sunday. No work shall be allowed on Easter Sunday, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day and up to five (5) additional days during the course of the work that impact major church activities. The Contractor and SAWs Inspector will coordinate with Cornerstone Church and will accommodate the five additional days. These days can occur at any time and must not be assumed to be consecutive calendar days.

## And replace with:

Cornerstone Church (Reach 3 and 4) – Work may be done 24/7 except that no work shall be done in the expanded temporary construction easement on Saturday or Sunday. All activity on Saturday or Sunday must be contained within the reduced limits of the temporary construction easement as shown on the drawings. No material delivery, equipment delivery or hauling will be allowed on Saturdays or Sundays. Access will be allowed for work trucks only. Contractor shall move all temporary barriers (e.g. chain link fence, New Jersey Barriers, etc) and all equipment, materials, or miscellaneous items from the expanded temporary construction easement limits to the reduced temporary construction easement limits no later than midnight every Friday and no earlier than midnight on Sunday. No work shall be allowed on Easter Sunday, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day and up to five (5) additional days during the course of the work that impact major church activities. The Contractor and SAWs

Inspector will coordinate with Cornerstone Church and will accommodate the five additional days. These days can occur at any time and must not be assumed to be consecutive calendar days.

The remainder of the bid documents remain unchanged.
