#### CHANGES TO THE RFQ

### 1. Page 2, Section I. Project Information B., amend by adding #4 to read:

Design phase: With the expectation that both sites for the Project may be designed and constructed simultaneously, it is likewise anticipated that the design services will be performed by a single core group of Design Professionals, not two (2) separate A/E firms. While there are two (2) distinct sites, it is expected that there is a common single cohesive design approach with common core elements. Design deliverables for each site shall be produced and coordinated simultaneously. If the Respondent proposes a differing approach, it must be indicated in the Project Approach narrative within the Statements of Qualifications.

## 2. Page 5, of Addendum 2 Section II. C. 1. Project Team, Max Number of Pages that reads:

30 pages (page count does include resumes)

40 pages (page count does include resumes)

#### 3. Page 8, Section II. C. Project Approach, E. Safety Program and Records (4 points) that reads:

#### E. Safety Program and Records (4 points)

- 1) Provide a summary of Respondent's firm/team's safety record specifically for the projects that are represented in the "Design Team and Project Experience" section of the SOQ.
- 2) Respondent shall submit an example of a Safety Procedures Plan from a previous DB project, which should include:
  - a. Emergency Procedures
  - b. Safety Permits and Procedures for permitting
  - c. General Safety Requirements
  - d. Safety Program
  - e. Safety Procedures
  - f. Job Site Inspections
  - g. Fall Protection Policy
  - h. Lockout Tag Out Procedure
  - i. Confined Space Entry
  - j. Written Hazard Communication Program
  - k. Violation and Safety Assessment Procedure
  - I. Competent Person Verification Form
  - m. Site Inspection Report

## 4. Page 15, Section IV. Submitting a Response, B. 5. that reads:

Responses are limited to a maximum of <u>75</u> pages per submittal. A single side equals to a single page. **Required forms do not count toward the page limit**. Required forms are the Submittal Response Checklist, Respondent Questionnaire Insurance requirements, and Conflict of Interest Questionnaire.

### Is amended to read:

Responses are limited to a maximum of <u>85</u> pages per submittal. A single side equals to a single page. **Required forms do not count toward the page limit**. Required forms are the Submittal Response Checklist, Respondent Questionnaire Insurance requirements, and Conflict of Interest Questionnaire.

## 5. Page 15, Section IV. Submitting a Response, B. 6. that reads:

Responses should be clear, concise, and complete. They should be submitted using an 8 ½" by 11" portrait format. 11" by 17" inserts are also allowable, but will count as two (2) pages in the page count limitation. These pages *will* count towards the page limit amount of <u>75</u> pages.

## Is amended to read:

Responses should be clear, concise, and complete. They should be submitted using an 8  $\frac{11}{2}$  by 11" portrait format. 11" by 17" inserts are also allowable, but will count as two (2) pages in the page count limitation. These pages **will** count towards the page limit amount of <u>85</u> pages.
