3. Page 5, Section III. B. Mandatory Site Visits, is to be Deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

1. A map to the first location identified below, titled Twin Oaks Site Map, has been posted on SAWS' website as a separate document. Respondents may **not** ask verbal questions regarding this solicitation at the mandatory site visits scheduled for:

Tuesday, May 3, 2016
at 9:00 a.m. Central Time

2. Respondents should report and check in at the first location, where they will be provided a complete list of addresses for the remaining sites, a contact cell number, and travel maps. Respondents must provide their own transportation and should allow at least three (3) hours for the site visits and associated travel time. The first site is listed below with the address.

3. Attendance is required in order for the proposed Respondent to gain a better understanding of the project. As sign in sheet will be utilized at each of the sites to insure all attendees have visited each site. No late attendees will be allowed to join the group of Respondents that have already begun the site visit at the first site or any consecutive sites.
4. Attendees must have the required Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) to include safety shoes, safety vest, hard hat and safety glasses, as construction is ongoing at some sites for other projects. Due to space limitations, it is requested that Respondents utilize the least of number vehicles possible.
5. Any oral statements provided by SAWS shall not be official or binding on SAWS. Only written responses shall be official and all other forms of communication with any officer, employee or agent of SAWS shall not be binding on SAWS.
6. SAWS has a new security policy in place which requires all visitors to be escorted at all times by SAWS personnel. Therefore, it will be necessary for all persons attending the site visit to allow sufficient time to check-in. We recommend arriving at least one (1) hour prior to the start time at the first site visit.
7. Respondents will check-in at the guard station. The guard will ask to see the attendee's identification, preferably a driver's license, and will record the attendee's name, job title and company name. If you have a business card available, please provide this as well. Also, please advise the guard that you are here to attend a site visit at the location referenced above. A head count will be taken at precisely 9:00 a.m., and attendees will be escorted inside the property to the first site.
8. If the attendee is already in possession of a SAWS issued contractor badge, this is sufficient and should be worn upon entering the site visit location and kept on during the meeting and until exiting the premises.
