**4. Question:** Can we submit directly to you all for this or would we need to sub to a prime firm for these services?

**5. Question:** Can you provide a list of the current firms who serve under this contract?

Or, is Respondent’s scope limited to generating plans and specifications to allow future procurement of a contractor to perform sewer main cleanings and TV inspections?

*Response:* Respondent’s scope is to evaluate and generate plans and specifications, as necessary, to allow procurement of a contractor to perform sewer main cleanings and TV inspections.

9. **Question:** The RFQ mentions projects in SAWS water recycling centers, recycle water system, lift stations and other facilities. Do these systems/facilities include pipelines?

*Response:* No. However, associated pipe work may be a part of a work order scope.
