



Highland Park North Water Main Replacement

This project will replace and upsize approximately 9,400 LF of water main just southeast of downtown. The neighborhood is bordered by HWY 90 and IH 37. It includes upsizing 6-inch and replacing existing 8-inch cast iron and asbestos cement mains with new 8-inch HDPE mains. An existing 24-inch asbestos cement main will also be replaced with new 24-inch HDPE main. This project will also eliminate 3 dead ends mains to help improve flow in the system. Proposed work will take place in city council districts 2 and 3.

When Will Work Occur?

Estimated overall construction duration is 13 months.

What to expect:

Construction will take place mainly in the ROW of neighborhood streets. There will be traffic control required for all construction in the ROW. Water service will be affected when tie ins are occurring and the new mains are being put into service.
