Addendum 1: response to technical question for Bid no. 16-16129 Granular Activated Carbon System Media.

- 1. The SCOPE uses the language *precursor material*, and the water data information lists THM types. Is the primary responsibility of the carbon to remove natural organic material (precursor material) or the THMs listed? **Answer: The primary responsibility is to remove the organic material in order to reduce the THM levels to drinking water standards.**
- 2. We understand that there are (6) 20,000-lb. vessels. Is the plan to provide the slurry out/in for (1) 20,000-lb. per day with the (6) days spread out over the 2017 calendar year? Slurry trucks can only hold 30,000 lbs. Answer: SAWS expects to have all of the carbon media, 120,000 lbs. replaced completely when requested during the year. The exchange may last several consecutive weeks in order to keep the plant facility in operation at all times.
- 3. How much advanced notification will be given prior to the slurry jobs needing completed? **Answer: SAWS** will notify the vendor at least a month in advance prior to needing the new carbon media.
- 4. For the Technical Assistance/Support, is the expectation that a technical advisor be onsite during the service event? Can the technical support be provided via phone or email communication? **Answer: Technical support can be provided via phone or email communication.**
- 5. Upon bid acceptance, are you able to ship us a one quart sample of carbon from one of the vessels for profiling into our reactivation plant? **Answer: Yes.**
- 6. Do you have any information on the mesh size or the effective size that is required? This will allow us to determine the proper product to use in our bid submittal.

Answer: Typical properties of the carbon currently used by SAWS are as follows:

U.S. Sieve, 90 wt% min. 12 x 30 Iodine Number, mg/g, min. 1100 Apparent Density, (dense packing)

7. Do you know what product you are currently using and when it was installed? **Answer: SAWS is** currently using TIGG 5DC 1230. The last carbon exchange was performed in July 2016.
