Concerning the installation floater; Page 28 of 48 Item 6.....Does the insured amount of the installation floater have to be 100% of the contract or can it be for the declared value of the equipment only? **Answer:**Yes For example: Contract is \$400,000, but equipment cost is \$300,000. What value will installation floater have to be **Answer:** \$400,000.00
- 2. We're seeking your approval of Arctic Chiller to be listed as an equal chiller manufacture and be added in your bid package as such. **Answer:** Yes: we would consider as a equal, please consider Artic cooler.
- 3. Is the mechanical contractor only responsible for the electrical from disconnect to the chiller? **Answer:** NO. SAWS will be responsible for all electrical from chiller to mcc panel
- 4. Will the mechanical contractor only be responsible for the Interface on the controls? **Answer:** Yes, they are only responsible for interface on the chiller, but must have the capability to extract all points from the chiller to BMS system.
- 5. Can work be performed during regular business hours? **Answer:** YES
- 6. Is this project Prevailing wage? Answer: NO
- 7. Does SAWS have specific requirements on disposing of water on existing piping systems (supply, return, and condenser)? **Answer:** NO
- 8. Who services and maintains the existing control system? Answer: COMPUTROLS

- 16. Can one chiller in each mechanical room service it's respective building? **Answer:** Yes As in, we will not need a CHW system shutdown to replace old chillers. Correct, we will not shutdown redundant chiller during installation.
- 17. Please confirm there is no requirement for chemical treatment with this project? **Answer:** There will be no chemical treatment with this project.
