Questions and responses to questions:

1. Regarding the bid for the annual contract for underground tank /line testing and leak detector testing, since there is not a unit cost for leak detector or line testing do we assume this will be covered in our cost for each Tank Testing (to include line and leak detector)?

Response: The line and leak detector testing should be included with the tank testing.

2. In the case one of the tests fail, what are the responsibilities of the awarded contractor at that point?

Response: The contractor would be responsible for notifying SAWS POC as soon as possible of the failed test. SAWS would then contact our pump and tank repair contractor to correct the problem. We would then contact the testing contractor to retest until it passes.
