## **QUESTIONS:**

- 1. Can we access the site to look at it? Yes. Bidders will be allowed to visit the site on Wednesday, June 23, 2010, between the hours of 8:00 AM and Noon.
- 2. What is the size, weight and dimensions of the concrete mixer to be moved? The base of the concrete mixer is 10'x10'. The mixer has a rear axle with wheels and a trailer hitch. A truck will be required to move the mixer. See attached photo of mixer. A crane will be required to erect the mixer at the final location. Note: A TX-DOT oversize and overweight permit and temporary license plate will be required to transport the mixer.   Contractor will be required to remove wheels and return to Owner.
- 3. Is the mixer presently disconnected and ready to be moved? Yes. The mixer is new and is currently disconnected and is sitting in the Eastside Service Center Parking lot ready for transport.
- 4. Who is responsible for the cost of testing on this project? In one place in the Specifications it states that SAWS will pay for testing and in another place it states that the Contractor is responsible. The contractor will be responsible for testing and forwarding the testing results to the Engineer in a timely manner. All test areas not meeting specification will be required to be removed and replace at no additional cost to the Owner.
- 5. Are there any contaminated soils or materials that will need to be disposed of? No.
- 6. Will the existing material piles be relocated to another location on this site? Yes. The existing material will need to be relocated to accommodate construction. Final location of material to be coordinated with Northeast Service Center Operations Manager.
