A. Bidding and Contract Requirement Revisions:

Item 1: Invitation to Bidders (IV-1), paragraph 3

a) DELETE the following sentence:

and REPLACE with the following (changes to original text are indicated by underlining):

Invitation to Bidders (IV-1), paragraph 5

b) DELETE the following sentence:

"Sealed bids will be received by the Contract Administration Division, 2800 U.S. Hwy 281 North, Customer Center Building, Suite 171, San Antonio, Texas 78212, until 10:00 AM (CST), October 28, 2010. Bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud in Contract Administration, Suite 169, Customer Center Building, 2800 U.S. Hwy 281 North, San Antonio, Texas. Each bid must be accompanied by a cashier's check, certified check, or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent of the total bid price."

and REPLACE with the following (changes to original text are indicated by underlining):

"Sealed bids will be received by the Contract Administration Division, 2800 U.S. Hwy 281 North, Customer Center Building, Suite 171, San Antonio, Texas 78212, until **2:00 PM (CST), October 28, 2010**. Bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud in Contract Administration, Suite 169, Customer Center Building, 2800 U.S. Hwy 281 North, San Antonio, Texas. Each bid must be accompanied by a cashier's check, certified check, or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent of the total bid price."

Item 2: Bid Proposal

- a) DELETE Section "Bid Proposal" in its entirety (16 pages) and REPLACE with the attached Bid Proposal, Pages BP-1 to BP-16, Addendum No. 1 (10/20/2010). The following change was made:
 - Reduce Bid Item 46. "CPS Energy Allowance" from \$450,000 to \$100,000.

Item 3: Special Conditions

a) Add the following on Page SC-4 as Item 17
 "All test runs for bypass pumping must take place on a weekday only, not a weekend."

Item 4: Specification Section 01010, Summary of Work

a) Add the following on Page 01010-3 at the end of Article 1.02.B.3.6:
 "CONTRACTOR shall intall 45 degree bends at pump discharge as necessary to allow for clearance between pump discharge pipe and access hatch frame."

Item 5: Specification Section 11310, Wet Pit Submersible Pumps For Wastewater (Size 15 Hp – 60 Hp)

- a) DELETE Article 2.01 A.2. in its entirety and REPLACE with the following: "2. Engineer/Owner approved pump manufacturer."
- b) Clarification: In addition to published catalog pump curves, the pump manufacturer shall furnish certified pump curves in conformance with Article 1.04 H in Section 11310 of the Specifications.

Item 6: Specification Section 11311, Wet Pit Submersible Pumps For Wastewater (Size 5 Hp – 10 Hp)

a) Clarification: In addition to published catalog pump curves, the pump manufacturer shall furnish certified pump curves in conformance with Article 1.04 H in Section 11311 of the Specifications.

Item 7: Specification Section 11312, Wet Pit Submersible Grinder Pumps for Wastewater

a) Clarification: In addition to published catalog pump curves, the pump manufacturer shall furnish certified pump curves in conformance with Article 1.04 H in Section 11312 of the Specifications.

B. Drawing Revisions:

Item 1: Electrical Design Sheets

- a) Clarification: All specified submersible pressure level transducers shall be supplied with a 24 VDC power supply and 4-20MA intrinsic safety barrier. The power supply and safety barrier shall be DIN rail mounted and located inside the Pump Control Panel. The intrinsic safety barrier shall be Siemens #IS1-2 or approved equal. The 24 VDC power supply shall be IDEC, 15W #PS5R-SB24 or approved equal. This clarification may similarly apply to Plan sheets E-192-4, E-223-4, E-238-3, E-6-H, E-8-H, E-8-H1, E-8-S, E-8-S1, and the Pump Control Panel Material table on sheets E-192-8, E-223-8, E-223-8, E-238-6 and E-6-S.
- b) Clarification: The 120 VAC control power for the Interposing Relays is to be fed from the Pump Control Panel, in lieu of the SCADA Panel's UPS branch controls fuse / disconnect, line #425 or #427 as currently shown on the Plans. Retain the relay power circuit controls fuse / disconnect for a spare, line #425 or #427 as is currently shown on the Plans. Provide new controls fuse / disconnect at the Pump Control Panel for the 120 VAC control power circuit used by the HydroRanger 200, convenience outlet, cabinet light, alarm horn, etc. for the Interposing Relays. This clarification may similarly apply to Plan sheets E-192-5, E-192-6 (line #427), E-192-7, E-223-5, E-223-6, E-223-7 (line #427), E-238-4, E-238-5, E-238-6 (line #427), E-248-3, E-248-4 (line #425), E-249-4 (line #425), E-8-H, E-8-H1, E-10-H, E-11-H (line #427), E-8-S, E-8-S1, E-9-S1, E-10-S, E-11-S (line #425).

C. Questions Received During Q&A Period of Non-mandatory Pre-bid Meeting:

Q1: Is this just for the pump station or is there any significant piping associated with the project? If there is piping, what is the approx. length, size and type of pipe used?

This project involves the rehabilitations of 38 lift stations. Please refer to the Technical Specifications, Section 01010 Summary of Work and the Plan Drawings of the Contract Documents for more clarifications.

- Q2: Is there any jacking and boring or directional boring associated with the installation of the pipes?

 Jacking and boring or directional boring is not anticipated with the installation of the pipes on this project.
- Q3: What is the approx. cost estimate of the whole project?

Engineers Opinion of Probable Construction Cost (OPCC) is \$10,800,000.00. Note that the Bid Item 46, CPS Energy Allowance will be reduced from \$450,000 to \$100,000 thereby reducing the OPCC to \$10,450,000.00.

Q4: Are there any Minority setaside requirements for this project?

SAWS does not have set-asides. However, SAWS does have an aspirational goal of 17% minority participation for all SAWS construction projects. Although the 17% goal is not required, we ask vendors to put forth a good faith effort to meet or exceed the goal.

Q5: Are you going to have a prebid meeting?

As referenced in the Invitation to Bidders of the Contract Documents, the Pre-bid Meeting was scheduled, and held at SAWS on Tuesday, October 12, 2010 @, 9:00 am.

Q6: I am trying to get the Hydromatic submersible pumps and Self Priming pumps approved for this project. SAWS has existing pumps in a majority of it lift station now. I have been in contact with the supervisors of the lift stations and they have no problem with the Hydromatic line being approved. Please advise me on how to get this accomplished.

The pump Specifications of the Contract Documents (Sections 11310, 11311, and 11312) indicate that pump manufacturers shall be 1) Pumps shall be the product of ITT Flygt Corporation, or 2) Engineer/Owner approved pump manufacturer.

Engineer/Owner acknowledge that other pump manufacturers are acceptable lift station submersible and self-priming pump manufacturers; however, for this project, bidders shall base their bids on the specific pumps as described, and as indicated in the Technical Specifications and the Plan Drawings of the Contract Documents. Bidders are advised to reference the Technical Specifications of the Contract Documents, including Section 01600 Product Requirement, Article 2.2, Product Substitution (Page 01600-7) for requirements for review and approval of equipment and materials different than as explicitly shown in the Plan Drawings and Technical Specifications of the Contract Documents. (Note that the Owner will not pre-approve any product substitutions prior to Bid Opening).

Q7: I am not 100% for certain that Hoffman and McLean are not already approved manufacturers for SAWS....How do I go about checking on that first before I go through the approval process? This particular project is specified Kooltronic or equal.

SAWS could accept an "or equal" as long as it meets the requirements of the Technical Specifications and Plan Drawings of the Contract Documents for this project. The Kooltronics is a preference/approved by the Owner. The Contractor who is awarded the project can submit on an a/c unit other than Kooltronics as long the Contractor can provide adequate proof and information/justification to SAWS/Owner and the Engineer that it is an equal to the Kooltronics.

Q8: The Kooltronic unit that is called out, KNA4C3P21L, is not constructed out of 316L stainless steel. The enclosures and wireway are to be constructed out of 316L so I would assume that the a/c should be as well. We would definitely be quoting a 316L unit so if Kooltronic is substantially less expensive, I would definitely question what type of material they are using.

Yes, the Kooltronic unit itself is not constructed of 316SS. We are not requiring the a/c unit to be 316SS, only the enclosure and wireway.

Q9: The proposed pipe drawings for the lift stations with submersible pumps show the discharge pipe to penetrate through the roof of the wet wells. It has been our experience that the discharge pipe will not clear the proposed hatches without installing opposing 45 deg bends on the pump bases. Has anyone checked that the proposed pipe modifications will clear the proposed hatches as drawn on the plans?

Please refer to Detail 7, on Sheet D-8 states "Contractor shall confirm size and location of wetwell access hatches per selected hatch and pump manufacturer's requirements (with 3' X 4' minimum clearance)". If 45 degree bends are required, contractor shall submit a detailed drawing for engineer/owner review and approval.

Q10: As a matter of clarification, is SAWS looking to receive bids through General Contract ors or through the Electricals?

SAWS cannot dictate what type Contractor bids the project. However, the Contractor and / or their Subcontractors must have the experience and ability to comply with and perform the necessary work as detailed in the Contract Documents (Plan Drawings and Specifications). Experience shall be documented in the "Bidder's Experience" form of the Bid Proposal.

Q11: On the above [referenced project] the Lift Station Sites have a ATS or MTS, and each transfer switch is required to have a 3 - PFR's for example as shown on Drawing E-057-3 and E-061-2. What PFR should be utilized?

Note 3. on Plan Drawing sheets E-11-H & E-11-S specifies what type PFR should be utilized.

Q12: Drawing E-221-2 Note 11, E-233-2 Note 8, Drawing E-236-2 Note 10, states install 8 - 1P/20A Breakers in existing 120/240V Panel who is the manufacturer of the existing Panels?

The required single pole, 20 amp breakers should not be a significant amount of cost differential between various panel manufacturers.

- Q13: The bid for has 5% on the mobilization item, the norm is 10%. Is this a typo or is 5% correct?

 The maximum of 5% for mobilization / demobilization is correct, this is not a typo.
- Q14: The bid time is set for 10am. Since there are so many items to write in is there a possibility of moving this one to 2pm?

Bid opening Time has been changed from 10:00 AM (CST) to 2:00 PM (CST) on October 28, 2010.

Q15: Each Lift station has a TVSS connected to each Service Disconnect and calls for the TVSS to be in a NEMA 4X 316SS. Can the TVSS be provided in NEMA 4X 304SS in lieu of NEMA 4X 316SS Enclosure?

NEMA 4X 304SS enclosures will not be allowed. SAWS had problems in the past using 304SS. It has been found 304SS is not as good of a corrosion inhibitor as 316SS for SAWS sewer lift stations.
