# Good Faith Effort Plan (GFEP) FAQs

#### • Q: Is the 20% SMWB goal mandatory?

A: No, but we ask prime contractors to do their best with good faith outreach efforts. If the goal is not met, proof of outreach efforts is required with the submittal.

#### • Q:What if I am having trouble finding SMWB subcontractors?

A:The SCTRCA has a search portal at <u>www.sctrca.sctrca.org</u>. Please make sure to include SAWS-specific parameters in your search. Contact Marisol Robles at <u>Marisol.Robles@saws.org</u> if assistance is needed.

# Q:What if my business is SMWB-certified? Do I need to find SMWB subs? A: If your firm is SMWB-certified, you will most likely meet the goal. However, the GFEP is a required document, and a good faith outreach effort is still necessary.

• Q: Do I need to include all my subcontractors in the GFEP or just those that qualify towards the SMWB goal?

A:All subcontractors need to be included in the GFEP, even those that may not count towards the SMWB goal.





### Contract Requirements

Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis beginning on the start date indicated on the Notice to Proceed
- Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
- Late payrolls delay contractor payments, as well as release of retainage at the end of the project
- Payroll records are subject to review
- Site visits are random and unannounced
- Interviews will be conducted and will be private & confidential
- All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting

### Contract Requirements

- Insurance requirements are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs Supplemental Conditions
  - Pollution, Installation Floater is required in lieu of Builder's Risk
- Selected contractor's insurance must be compliant with all other contracts
- SAWS will request insurance certificate prior to Board award to ensure insurance compliance and to assist in expediting execution of the contract
- Selected contractor must ensure insurance is compliant for the duration of the contract

### Contract Requirements

Apparent Low Bidder (Continued)

- To provide the following within one (1) business day
  - Statement of Bidder's Experience Form
    - Record of performance on three (3) distinct projects
    - Demonstrates construction of a minimum of 1,000 LF of 12 inch (or larger) sanitary sewer main by Open Cut Method completed by the Bidder
    - Demonstrates construction of Sanitary Sewer Lift Station completed by Bidder or Sub
    - Demonstrates demolition of existing Sanitary Sewer Lift Station completed by Bidder or Sub
    - Projects must have been completed between 2016 and 2022
    - Ensure all project reference contact information provided is current and valid prior to submitting
  - Detailed Baseline Schedule
    - Estimated notice to proceed date of November 15, 2022

### **Bid Packet Preparation**

- Utilize the Bid Packet Checklist within the specifications
- Double check all mathematical calculations and verify all extensions
- Addendums are acknowledged on the Bid Proposals
  - Check the SAWS website regularly for addendum postings
  - It is possible to have multiple addendums



# **Bid Packet Preparation**

- Pay close attention to the Mobilization and Preparation of ROW line items on the Bid Proposal as they are broken down <u>by site/location</u>
- Bidders <u>must also</u> provide the combined cost of the sites/locations and enter a subtotal for Mobilization and Preparation of ROW (all sites combined)
- Ensure Mobilization & Prep ROW do not exceed the percentages allowed once subtotaled
- When preparing the bid tab, SAWS will verify both the subtotals and total of site/location line items. If there is a discrepancy the subtotal provided by the Bidder will take precedence to correct the bid.

# **Bid Opening Procedures**

- Bids will be submitted using SAWS' electronic bid opening procedures
- SAWS encourages and prefers the submission of electronic bids using its secure FTP site.
  - Bidders should submit a request via email to obtain access to the site no later than 24 hours before the bid opening.
- Or, Bidders may drop off a hard copy bid. Only required items.
  - Drop box is located at 2800 US Hwy 281 N, Customer Service Tower
    - Enter the first set of glass double doors
    - Insert into the black drop box on the wall on the left-hand side
- Late bids will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.
- Bid Opening will be handled via WebEx only; link found in IFB



#### Tree Protection:

SAWS will provide Tree permit to the Contractor. Contractor is advised to proceed with caution when working near these areas and coordinate with CoSA Arborist as required.

#### CoSA Coordination:

SAWS will provide floodplain permit to the contractor. Contractor is advised to proceed with caution when working near these areas during rain events. 

Work performed and materials furnished shall be considered subsidiary to pipe rehabilitation work and/or Lift Station work.


