# Good Faith Effort Plan (GFEP) FAQs

### • Q: Is the 20% SMWB goal mandatory?

A: No, but we ask prime contractors to do their best with good faith outreach efforts. If the goal is not met, proof of outreach efforts is required with the submittal.

### • Q:What if I am having trouble finding SMWB subcontractors?

A:The SCTRCA has a search portal at <u>www.sctrca.sctrca.org</u>. Please make sure to include SAWS-specific parameters in your search. Contact Marisol Robles at <u>Marisol.Robles@saws.org</u> if assistance is needed.

- Q:What if my business is SMWB-certified? Do I need to find SMWB subs?
   A: If your firm is SMWB-certified, you will most likely meet the goal. However, the GFEP is a required document, and a good faith outreach effort is still necessary.
- Q: Do I need to include all my subcontractors in the GFEP or just those that qualify towards the SMWB goal?

A:All subcontractors need to be included in the GFEP, even those that may not count towards the SMWB goal.

### **Contract Requirements**

Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis beginning on the start date indicated on the Notice to Proceed, even in non-performing weeks
- Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
- Late payrolls delay contractor payments, as well as release of retainage at the end of the project
- Payroll records are subject to review
- Site visits are random and unannounced
- Interviews will be conducted and will be private & confidential
- All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting work

### Contract Requirements

- Insurance requirements are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs
   Installation Floater is required in lieu of Builder's Risk
- Contractor's insurance must be compliant on all other SAWS projects
- SAWS will request insurance certificate prior to Board award to ensure insurance compliance and to assist in expediting execution of the contract
- Contractor must ensure insurance is compliant for the duration of the contract

### **Contract Requirements**

• Contractor shall perform the work with its own organization on at least 40% of the total original contract price which should be indicated on the Good Faith Effort Plan.

### **Contract Requirements**

- Notified by SAWS within 24 hours of Bid Opening to provide the following:
  - Conflict of Interest Questionnaire Form CIQ (Rev. 1/1/2021)
  - Proof of Insurability
  - Company Information Packet
  - Statement regarding ability to complete the project
  - W-9
  - Detailed Baseline Schedule
  - Statement of Bidder's Experience
  - \*And, if bid was submitted electronically without a Bid Bond:
  - Cashier's Check or Certified Check

## **Bid Packet Preparation**

- Only limited items are required with the initial bid packet
  - List of Bid Items
  - Bid Packet Checklist
  - Signed Bid Proposal Signature Page with
    - Acknowledgement of all Addenda
    - Executive Order
  - Signed Proposal Certification
  - Bid Bond
  - Good Faith Effort Plan

### **Bid Packet Preparation**

- Utilize the Bid Packet Checklist within the specifications
- Double check all mathematical calculations and verify all extensions
- Ensure Mobilization & Prep ROW Line Item does not exceed the percentage allowed
- Addendums are acknowledged on the Bid Proposal
  - Check the SAWS website regularly for addendum postings
  - It is possible to have multiple addendums
  - Known changes for Addendum:
    - Currently there is no addendum issued

# Bid Packet Preparation (cont.)

- Bidder shall ensure that the 3 projects submitted on the Statement of Bidder's Experience form are:
  - Of similar size and scope as indicated on the check boxes
  - A-I and A-2 must be completed by the Bidder (submitting prime contractor)
  - A-3 can be completed by the Bidder or Sub-Contractor
  - Completed between 2016-2021
  - Owner references (entity bidder contracted with)
  - Verifiable with up-to-date contact information for the Owner
- Failure to complete the form properly or not having all of the requested experience may result in the bid being found non-responsive.

# **Bid Opening Procedures**

- Bids will be submitted using SAWS' electronic bid opening procedures
- Submission of electronic bids preferred using SAWS secure FTP site.
   Submit a request via email at least 24 hours before bid opening
- Or, Bidders may drop off a hard copy bid. Only required items.
  - Drop box is located at 2800 US Hwy 281 N, Customer Service Tower
    - Enter the first set of glass double doors
    - Insert into the black drop box on the wall on the left-hand side
- Late bids will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.
- Bid Opening will be handled via WebEx only; link found in IFB

### Project – Background

- The existing SAWS sewer line is adjacent to a quarry wall within the Freisenhahn property.
- In July of 2021 the Quarry wall failed and demolished MH 1010933.
- SAWS Operations performed point repair in previous location of MH and added fill to the area.








### Project – Location


• The proposed sanitary sewer main and easement are located at the Edwin R. Ripps Jr. property on the southwest side of San Antonio by Resnik Middle School and approximately 3,000' from Watson Road.





# Project – Description

- The project includes the construction of approximately 736' of 8"–12" sanitary sewer mains at 16' to 18' deep installed via open cut, including associated manhole replacements, bypass pumping and site restoration to reroute sewer away from quarry wall failure.
- Access to the site/SS easement will be through a driveway located along the SW Verano Pkwy.

### **Project – Special Conditions**

- SCI. The CONTRACTOR shall, to the extent allowed by law, list a landowner or other person or entity with an insurable interest as an additional insured on the Commercial General Liability (CGL) and Commercial/Business Automobile Liability (AL) policy(s) of insurance that CONTRACTOR is required to maintain under this Contract. Landowner shall be added as an additional insured if indicated in the landowner's easement agreement and upon request as needed.
- SCI.I Edwin R Ripps, JR. shall be added as an additional insured. Edwin R. Ripps requires the Contractor to carry and maintain a minimum coverage of \$2 Million dollars in Commercial General Liability and Commercial/Business Automobile Liability policy(s) of insurance.
- SC2. Geotechnical Engineering Study: A Geotechnical Engineering Study has been developed for SAWS on this
  project and will be made available to potential Bidders for informational purposes only.
  The contractor shall hire an independent geotechnical engineering firm to perform field activities as necessary
  in order to prepare a geotechnical report for the use of the Contractor.
