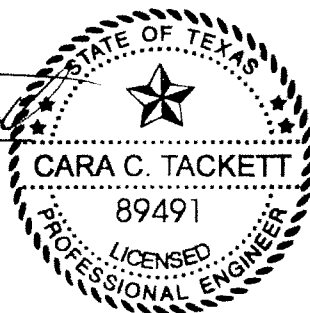

ADDENDUM NO. 2

A. GENERAL QUESTIONS/CLARIFICATIONS

1. **Question:** Can the 10' x 10' Junction Box be cast-in-place?

Response: Yes

2. **Question:** Is SAWS limiting the number of suppliers for the 10' x 10' junction box to "Old Castle" as stated in the plans or will other box suppliers be allowed?

Response: No, the junction box and grate inlet can be from other manufacturers however it will need to be approved by Pape-Dawson Engineers prior to the bid being awarded. If a junction box or grate inlet other than the one specified in the plans is to be used, please submit a detail and the manufacturer information with your bid. The junction box does not have to be pre-cast but must meet City of San Antonio Unified Development code for concrete strength and number of re-bar.

3. **Question:** What are the pay limit for 13,093 S.Y. of Seeding/Hydromulch?

Response: Any soil area that is disturbed should be seeded with hydrolmulch.

4. **Question:** Is this seeding bid item intended to be used on the earthen channel being constructed by others and if so what is the completion date for this work?

Response: Yes. The completion date should be within 2 weeks of the completion of earthen channel construction.

5. **Question:** Is the concrete pilot channel in the middle of the earthen channel part of this contract?

Response: No, the concrete pilot channel will not be constructed.

6. **Question:** Please clarify the length of the dirt berm that is being built from the channel excavation on the southern portion of the earth channel as described on plan sheets C4.0, C4.1, C4.2, C4.3 & C4.4?

Response: All earthwork is being completed by the San Antonio Water System and this is not a concern for the portion of the project under this bid.

7. **Question:** Is what we will be removing and hauling off the existing 10'x6' Junction box and existing 6" concrete rip-rap or is there something else?

Response: That is correct, those are the only items to be hauled off.

8. **Question:** While working on the specifications for this project, I came across some missing sections as compared to the table of contents. They are Workers' Compensation

Coverage Requirements and Supplemental Conditions. Can you please email or fax these sections to us, or let us know whether or not they are needed.

Response: Workers Compensation Coverage is included in the Specs.

There are no Supplemental Conditions for this project.

RISK ASSESSMENT

SAWS GCCC-Section 5.7. Contractor's Insurance Requirements adequately specifies the lines of insurance coverage with one exception: Section 5.7.1.1.7 – the Contractor Pollution Liability line of coverage is hereby waived.

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

Item 23 shall be removed and replaced with the following:

23. To assist the San Antonio Water System Contracting Office in performing the bidder evaluation and subsequent recommendation of award, the apparent low bidder will submit the following items with their bid on the day of the bid opening. Failure to provide the required information with the bid, may result in determining a non-responsive bidder:

- (a) A complete financial statement for your organization that was prepared within the past 12 months, by an independent Certified Public Accountant, and a point of contact for your banking institution.
- (b) An information packet on company showing experience, organization and equipment.
- (c) A statement regarding ability to complete the project within the schedule taking into account existing commitments.
- (d) Record of performance on three (3) similar projects completed within the last 5 years including name of project, amount of project, project duration, name, address, and telephone number of contact person for each project.
- (e) A completed and signed W-9 Request for Taxpayer Identification Number and Certification
- (f) Reservation of Rights: SAWS reserves its right to ask for additional projects or clarification of information submitted to complete the review of or establish a bidder's record of performance."

Article V-Contract Responsibilities

Section 5.4 of the general conditions shall be amended as follows:

SUPERINTENDENTS - The Contractor shall keep on-site pursuant to this Project during its progress a competent full time Superintendent who is a direct employee of the prime contractor and any necessary assistants, all satisfactory to the Owner. The appointment of a designee in lieu of a full time superintendent shall not be allowed as part of this provision, therefore any reference to "designee" shall not be applicable. The remaining section of this section shall remain the same.
