2. BIDDING AND CONTRACT DOCUMENTS:

- A) The bid opening time for Package I is being changed to Tuesday, May 28th, 1:30 PM.
- B) The bid opening time for Package II is being changed to Tuesday, May 28th, 3:30 PM.

- C) Proposal Certification: REPLACE this page entirely with the revised Proposal Certification Page. (attached)
- D) Supplemental Conditions: ADD Supplemental Condition Page. (attached)

Response to Bidders Questions

- Q1 I don't see the location map included in the RFP document. Could you please issue this as well?
 - A1: No location map will be issued. Please disregard any reference to a location map in the bid documents. Project sites are unspecified.
- Q2 The bid opening time frame between Package I & Package II is 30 minutes. That is not enough time to allow bidders to make any adjustment in their bid prices. SAWS has in the past allowed 4 hours between the bid packages so contractors could make any adjustments needed. Will SAWS reconsider the bid opening time on these two packages to allow more time between the bid openings?
 - A2: Please see the "Bidding and Contract Documents" section of this addendum for changes to bid opening times on Package I and II.
- Q3 Will the proposed manholes require coating the interior walls?
 - A3: Response: Yes, all manhole interior surfaces will require coating per SAWS standard specifications.
- Q4 If there is any flex base or ATB called out for in the future plans to be placed on ditches in Alley ROW? Will they be paid for under appropriated bid items for flex base or ATB? There is no way to know at his time what the plans will call for, therefore no way to cover these costs without appropriate bid items.
 - A4: A change order will be negotiated for items which are not on the bid proposal and required for an alley project. If an item is considered incidental per SAWS specifications no additional payment will be made.

The remainder of the bid documents remains unchanged.

Each bidder is requested to acknowledge receipt of this Addendum No. 2 by his/her signature affixed hereto and to file same as an attachment to his/her bid.

Supplemental Condition

Article VI- Contract Changes

Section 6.5.4.4 of the General Conditions shall be supplemented as follows:

Equipment: For Contractor-owned machinery, trucks, power tools or other equipment, necessary for use on Change Order work, the Rental Rate Blue Book for Construction Equipment (hereafter referred to as "Blue Book") rate, as modified by the following, will be used to establish Contractor's allowable hourly rental rates. Equipment used shall be at the rates in effect for each section of the Blue Book at the time of use. The following formula shall be used to compute the hourly rates:

 $H = M \times R1 \times R2 + OP$

Where H = Hourly Rate

M = Monthly Rate

R1 = Rate Adjustment Factor

R2 = Regional Adjustment Factor

OP = Operating Costs

If Contractor-owned machinery and/or equipment is not available and equipment is rented from an outside source, the hourly rate shall be established by dividing the actual invoice cost by the actual number of hours the equipment is involved in the Work. Owner reserves the right to limit the hourly rate to comparable Blue Book rates. When the invoice specifies that the rental rate does not include fuel, lubricants, repairs and servicing, the Blue Book hourly operating cost shall be allowed to be added for each hour the equipment operates. The allowable equipment hourly rates shall be paid for each hour that the equipment is involved in the Work and an additional maximum of fifteen percent (15%) may be added as compensation.

The remaining sections of Article VI shall remain the same.
