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1. Is the PDM benchmarking for vibration only?

2. Is integration with EAM (enterprise asset management system) part of scope? If so, what system is being used?

Response: *No substitutions. BETAVIB is the portable vibration hardware and software used by SAWS. Consultant shall review the tools (BETAVIB) utilized by the SAWS Predictive Maintenance (PDM) staff. The consultant will assess and report any skill gaps amongst the PDM staff and recommend steps to reduce or mitigate. The consultant will assess skills and competencies of the PDM team with respect to vibration equipment (BETAVIB) and software, various vibration diagnostic techniques, as well as access to supporting training and educational content.*
