

## 2021 Dead End Water Main Elimination Project

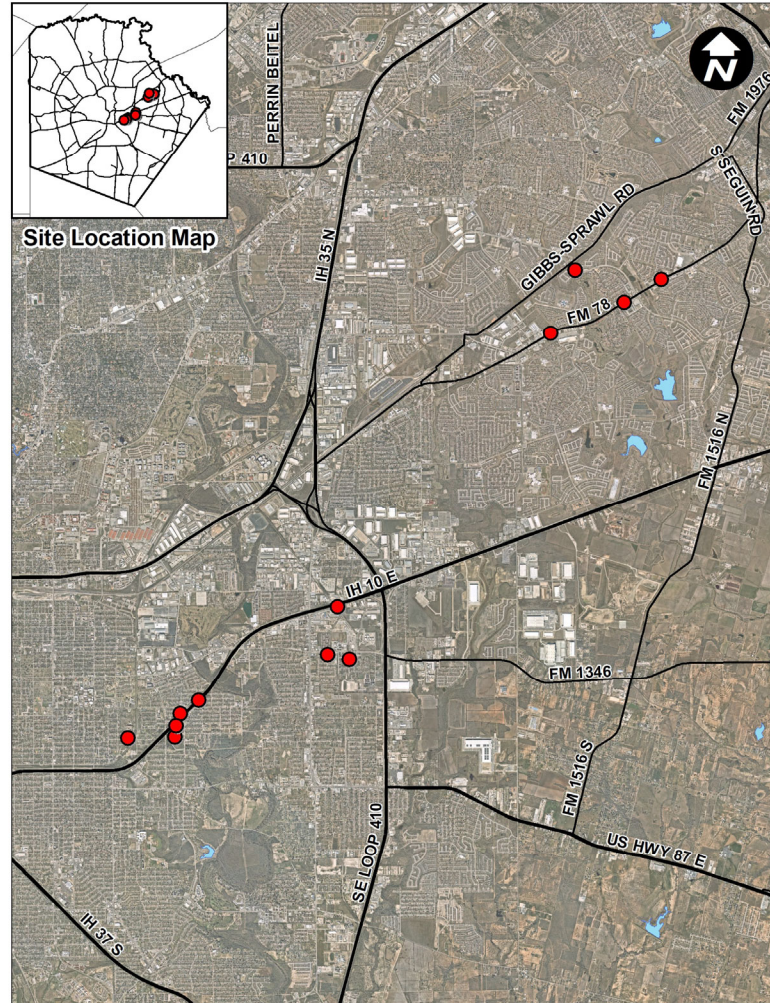
This project consists of ten (10) site locations located in the inner west of the City of San Antonio, installing approximately 7286 linear feet of water mains.

### When Will Work Occur?

Estimated construction duration is 720 days.

### Construction Elements:

- ✓ This project will address the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) regulation to eliminate Dead End Mains and reduce the overall number of Dead End Mains required to be flushed. This project will also improve connectivity in Pressure Zones 3, 4, 828, and 950E and will help improve existing pressure and flow issues during periods of peak demand.
- ✓ Construction on this project for some sites will be within the City of San Antonio, TXDOT, and UPRR ROW.
- ✓ Construction of the water main replacement is via Open Cut or Trenchless technologies.
- ✓ Disruption to Water service is anticipated at some sites.
- ✓ There will be increased heavy truck traffic in the vicinity of the project.
