Good Faith Effort Plan (GFEP) FAQs

Q: Is the 20% SMWB goal mandatory?

A: No, but we ask prime contractors to do their best with good faith outreach efforts. If the goal is not met, proof of outreach efforts is required with the submittal.

Q:What if I am having trouble finding SMWB subcontractors?

A: The certification agency has a search portal at www.sctrca.org. Or you may email the SMWB Program

Manager with the scopes of work you are seeking. You will receive lists of local SMWB-certified firms to contact.

Q:What if my business is SMWB-certified? Do I need to find SMWB subs?

A: If your firm is SMWB-certified, you will most likely meet the goal. However, the GFEP is a required document, and a good faith outreach effort is still necessary.

Q: Do I need to include all my subcontractors in the GFEP or just those that qualify towards the SMWB goal?

A: All subcontractors and suppliers (both SMWB and Non-SMWB) need to be included in the GFEP.





Bid Packet Preparation

- Utilize the Bid Packet Checklist within the specifications
 - All items due with the bid
- Double check all mathematical calculations and verify all extensions
- Addendums are acknowledged on the Bid Proposals
- References and contact information must be verified prior to submitting bid(s)



Contract Requirements

Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis
- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
- Site visits are random and unannounced
- Interviews will be Conducted and will be private & confidential
- Payroll records are subject to review
- All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting
- Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
- Late payrolls delay contractor payments from SAWS



Contract Requirements

- Insurance requirements are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs
 - -Pollution Liability is required
 - -Maintain insurance coverage during the construction of this Project
- Compliant prior to executing the contract
- Will ask for insurance prior to Board award to expedite execution of the contract
 - Any deficiencies must be corrected prior to Board award

Project Overview

- The San Antonio Water System is soliciting proposals for the purpose of retaining a Contractor to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, and supervision to assist in the inspection of water distribution mains throughout SAWS Condition Assessment Program.
- Schedules will be provided through each work order proposal before any condition assessment is to begin.
- Unspecified work order contract
- Throughout SAWS Service Area.
- Total of twenty nine (29) Line Items located within the Bid Proposal (pages BP-I through BP-4)



Supplemental Conditions

- Contractor shall obtain and pay for all permits
- Project signs shall comply with COSA regulations
- Documentation and tracking through CPMS



- SC-2.02 Work Orders
 - One work order for each condition assessment inspection
 - Will include multiple locations
 - To include:
 - System maps with location, key assets, and boundaries
 - Photos
 - As-builts with callouts defining required effort
 - Shutdown maps identifying valves if required
 - Mandatory pre-construction meeting for each WO
 - Between Contractor, SAWS, and the CA Vendor



- SC-2.02 Work Orders
 - Preliminary Site Investigation
 - Any businesses, residences, or facilities affected by construction
 - Traffic control
 - Valves requiring locating and/or exposure
 - Fee Proposal
 - After site investigation and pre-construction meeting
 - To include required line items
 - To include proposed schedule of work
 - Within 14 days of pre-con meeting
 - NTP after proposal is accepted by SAWS



- SC-2.04 Performance Time
 - Non-Emergency
 - Commence within 14 days of NTP
 - Completed by agreed upon Schedule of Work
 - SAWS may extend due to unforeseen circumstances
 - Emergency
 - During working hours (7am-5pm)
 - Mobilization within 2 hours
 - Only during planned timeframes



- SC-2.10 Tapping of Pipelines
 - To be determined dependent on CA technology used
 - Details provided in Appendix A
 - CSC hot taps must be performed by original manufacturer (15% markup)
- SC-2.12 Miscellaneous Allowance
 - Payment of services required due to CA results encountered during CA and leak detection inspections
 - Time and Materials, 15% markup allowable



Special Provisions to the Technical Specifications

Pages SPTS-1 through SPTS-3

- 100.3 Standby Support Services
 - Crew to follow CA vendor for potholing services
- 804.9 Excavation, Trenching and Backfill
 - General Potholing on an hourly rate, hydro-vac
 - Dewatering Pump on an hourly rate
- 826 Valve Box Adjustments
 - Valve box maintenance, including exposure, cleaning, removing of water, and clearing of pavement
