RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS

1. Question: For the FRP manholes, will tee-bases be required or are these close bottom manholes? Please provide a detail for these manholes.

Response: Tee-bases are required for the fiberglass manholes. All SAWS details can be found in the URL below. The Tee-Base Fiberglass manhole is detail DD852-11 Sheet 1 of 1. https://apps.saws.org/business_center/specs/constspecs/

- Question: Can you please provide details for the concrete manholes? Will they require flowable backfill? Will coating be required? If so, what is the approved coating for concrete manholes? Response: All details and specifications can be found using the URL below. The manholes will require flowable backfill. Coating is not required for concrete manholes. https://apps.saws.org/business center/specs/constspecs/
- **3. Question**: Can a bid item be added for clearing? Response: Any costs for clearing should be included in the Preparation of ROW line item.
- **4. Question**: Will you accept (FRP) fiberglass manholes for this project in lieu of the pre-cast concrete manholes which were specified?

Response: Yes, fiberglass manholes will be allowed as an alternate to concrete manholes. See Changes to the Specifications #1. Line items for fiberglass manholes have been added for those contractors wishing to include bids for these.

5. Question: For bid items 19, 36, and 38, will closed bottom fiberglass manholes be allowed as an alternate option to 48" sanitary sewer concrete manholes?

Response: Yes, see Changes to the Specifications #1. Line items for fiberglass manholes have been added for those contractors wishing to include bids for these.

CHANGES TO THE SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. Remove the Bid Proposal in its entirety and replace with the attached revised Bid Proposal. Line items have been added for bidders to provide prices for fiberglass manholes as an alternate to concrete manholes. Bidders shall use the revised bid proposal when submitting a bid for this project. Failure to use the revised version may result in the bid being found non-responsive.
- 2. Due to updates in the General Wage Decisions for Building Construction Type, remove the wage decision documents from the solicitation in entirety and replace with the revised versions attached to this addendum (rev. 01/12/2024 for General Decision Number TX20240231). This version should be utilized by the awarded contractor for this project.

CLARIFICATIONS

1. The Project Estimated Budget has increased from \$1,930,000.00 to \$3,900,000.00 and has been modified on the SAWS website.



Employees must be permitted to use paid sick leave for their own illness, injury or other health-related needs, including preventive care; to assist a family member (or person who is like family to the employee) who is ill, injured, or has other health-related needs, including preventive care; or for reasons resulting from, or to assist a family member (or person who is like family to the employee) who is a victim of, domestic violence, sexual assault, or stalking. Additional information on contractor requirements and worker protections under the EO is available at

Unlisted classifications needed for work not included within the scope of the classifications listed may be added after award only as provided in the labor standards contract clauses (29CFR 5.5 (a) (1) (iii)).

The body of each wage determination lists the classification and wage rates that have been found to be prevailing for the cited type(s) of construction in the area covered by the wage determination. The classifications are listed in alphabetical order of ""identifiers"" that indicate whether the particular rate is a union rate (current union negotiated rate for local), a survey rate (weighted average rate) or a union average rate (weighted union average rate).

Union Rate Identifiers

A four letter classification abbreviation identifier enclosed in dotted lines beginning with characters other than ""SU"" or ""UAVG"" denotes that the union classification and rate were prevailing for that classification in the survey. Example: PLUM0198-005 07/01/2014. PLUM is an abbreviation identifier of the union which prevailed in the survey for this classification, which in this example would be Plumbers. 0198 indicates the local union number or district council number where applicable, i.e., Plumbers Local 0198. The next number, 005 in the example, is an internal number used in processing the wage determination. 07/01/2014 is the effective date of the most current negotiated rate, which in this example is July 1, 2014.

Union prevailing wage rates are updated to reflect all rate changes in the collective bargaining agreement (CBA) governing this classification and rate.

Survey Rate Identifiers

Classifications listed under the ""SU"" identifier indicate that no one rate prevailed for this classification in the survey and the published rate is derived by computing a weighted average rate based on all the rates reported in the survey for that classification. As this weighted average rate includes all

rates reported in the survey, it may include both union and non-union rates. Example: SULA2012-007 5/13/2014. SU indicates the rates are survey rates based on a weighted average calculation of rates and are not majority rates. LA indicates the State of Louisiana. 2012 is the year of survey on which these classifications and rates are based. The next number, 007 in the example, is an internal number used in producing the wage determination. 5/13/2014 indicates the survey completion date for the classifications and rates under that identifier.

Survey wage rates are not updated and remain in effect until a new survey is conducted.

Union Average Rate Identifiers

Classification(s) listed under the UAVG identifier indicate that no single majority rate prevailed for those classifications; however, 100% of the data reported for the classifications was union data. EXAMPLE: UAVG-OH-0010 08/29/2014. UAVG indicates that the rate is a weighted union average rate. OH indicates the state. The next number, 0010 in the example, is an internal number used in producing the wage determination. 08/29/2014 indicates the survey completion date for the classifications and rates under that identifier.

A UAVG rate will be updated once a year, usually in January of each year, to reflect a weighted average of the current negotiated/CBA rate of the union locals from which the rate is based.

WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

- 1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:
- * an existing published wage determination
- * a survey underlying a wage determination
- * a Wage and Hour Division letter setting forth a position on a wage determination matter
- * a conformance (additional classification and rate) ruling

On survey related matters, initial contact, including requests for summaries of surveys, should be with the Wage and Hour National Office because National Office has responsibility for the Davis-Bacon survey program. If the response from this initial contact is not satisfactory, then the process described in 2.) and 3.) should be followed.

With regard to any other matter not yet ripe for the formal process described here, initial contact should be with the Branch of Construction Wage Determinations. Write to:

2.) If the answer to the question in 1.) is yes, then an interested party (those affected by the action) can request review and reconsideration from the Wage and Hour Administrator

(See 29 CFR Part 1.8 and 29 CFR Part 7). Write to:

The request should be accompanied by a full statement of the interested party's position and by any information (wage payment data, project description, area practice material, etc.) that the requestor considers relevant to the issue.

3.) If the decision of the Administrator is not favorable, an interested party may appeal directly to the Administrative Review Board (formerly the Wage Appeals Board). Write to:

4.) All decisions by the Administrative Review Board are final.
