



Hiawatha 16 Inch Water Main Replacement

Rebuilding Water Infrastructure in Your Neighborhood

San Antonio Water System will replaced existing water and sewer pipelines along Hiawatha St, along the alley from Dollarhide Ave to Stringfellow St. and down Stringfellow St. to E. Southcross, as shown in the project map. This project is necessary in an effort to improve our aging sewer and water system and offer customers the best quality system.

When Will Work Occur?

Project Construction is anticipated to begin in January 2020 with a project duration of approximately 365 calendar days.

Construction Elements:

- ✓ A traffic control plan, which may include a combination of lane closure and detour routes around the project site.
- ✓ Approximately 2,000 LF of 8-inch Sanitary Sewer and approximately 6,000 LF of 6, 8, and 16-inch water mains will be replaced.
- ✓ Approximately 6,000 feet of the project will be installed using new High-Density Polyethylene pipe technology.
- ✓ Temporary Water Lines will be installed so as to provide the least amount of service disruption time, as well as by-pass sewer pumping
