 Must have a <u>local office</u> or <u>local equipment</u> yard.



Good Faith Effort Plan (GFEP) FAQs

- Q: Is the 20% SMWB goal mandatory?
 - A: No, but we ask prime contractors to do their best with good faith outreach efforts. If the goal is not met, proof of outreach efforts is required with the submittal.
- Q:What if my business is SMWB-certified? Do I need to find SMWB subs?
 - A: If your firm is SMVVB-certified, you will most likely meet the goal. However, the GFEP is a required document, and a good faith outreach effort is still necessary.
- Q: Do I need to include all my subcontractors in the GFEP or just those that qualify towards the SMWB goal?
 - A: All subcontractors need to be included in the GFEP, even those that may not count towards the SMWB goal.
- Q:What if I have questions about the GFEP?





Prevailing Wage Rate and Labor Standards – Section 2.10 of the General Conditions

- Payroll records are subject to review
- Contractors to utilize LCP Tracker
- Certified payroll to be submitted on weekly basis for duration of the project
- Contractors are responsible for sub-contractor payroll
- Late payrolls may delay contractor payments and release of retainage from SAWS
- Wage decisions are included within the specifications
- Site visits are random and unannounced
- Interviews will be conducted and will be private & confidential
- All apprenticeship programs will need to be approved by Department of Labor prior to starting



Supplemental Conditions

- Insurance requirements are found in Section 5.7 of the GCs
 - Installation Floater coverage required in lieu of Builder's Risk
- Contractor must maintain insurance coverage for the duration of the construction Project
- Contractor's insurance must be compliant for all SAWS projects; otherwise, it may affect recommendation for award
- SAWS will ask for insurance prior to Board award to expedite execution of the contract
 - Must be compliant prior to execution of the contract and issuing the NTP



Supplemental Conditions

- Notified within 24 hours of Bid Opening
- To provide the following within one (I) business day
 - Conflict of Interest Questionnaire Form CIQ (Rev. 1/1/2021)
 - Proof of Insurability

 - Statement of Bidder's Experience Forms
 - *And, if bid was submitted electronically without a Bid Bond:
 - Cashier's Check or Certified Check



Supplemental Conditions

- Statement of Bidder's Experience Form(s)
 - Total of 4 forms (A-I to A-4)
 - A-I and A-2 performed by Bidder only
 - A-3 and A-4 can be performed by Bidder or Subcontractor
 - References must have valid contact information (previously verified)
 - Owner reference is defined as City, County, State, etc.
 - Thoroughly review check boxes on each form to ensure project complies with requested bidder experience



Supplemental Conditions (Continued)

 Contractor shall perform the work with its own organization on at least 40% of the total original contract price which should be indicated on the Good Faith Effort Plan.

Prime Contractor's Percentage of Participation: (Ex: 100% is the total value of the contract.)

Liquidated damages will be assessed at \$801.00 per day



Bid Packet Preparation

- Utilize the Bid Packet Checklist within the specifications
- Double check all mathematical calculations and verify all extensions
- Ensure Mobilization and Preparing Right-Of-Way do not exceed percentage (line items 1-77 only)
- Addendums are acknowledged on the Bid Proposals
 - Check our website regularly for addendum postings
 - It is possible to have multiple addendums during the time frame in addition to the scheduled final addendum

 - Enter the first set of glass double doors
 - Insert into the black drop box on the wall on the left hand side
- Late bids will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.




Contract Background

- Sealed bids are requested by the San Antonio Water System (SAWS) for the construction of approximately 4,288 linear feet of 8" and 12" existing sanitary sewer main to be rehabilitated by Open Cut Replacement, Pipe Curst, Cured-In-Place Pipe, miscellaneous point repairs, and associated manhole improvements for the BPC Central Small Diameter Package 4C, SAWS Job No.: 20-4523.
- Project Fund will finance this expenditure included in the CY 2021
- Project is part of the EPA Consent Decree (see Special Conditions)
- Contractor is to become familiar with the plans, specifications, and project location

Permit Requirements

- All traffic control plans must be submitted to and approved by TxDOT or CoSA as necessary for detours or other traffic impacts and signing.
- Contractor to follow requirements identified in corresponding permits (SAWS will apply for TxDOT Permit).
- Changes in field that are cited by TxDOT or CoSA Inspector will require concurrence and approval from the SAWS Inspector first.
- SAWS is obtaining Tree Permit from CoSA.
- Contractor is responsible for all other required permits per the General Conditions.



Other Requirements

- All RFIs, RFPs, submittals, and any other items related to construction must be uploaded and processed through CPMS.
- No work can be performed by the Contractor unless the cost for that line item is on the contract or unless otherwise directed by SAWS.
- Any Change Orders will be based as identified under section 6.5 of the General Conditions.



Special Provisions to the Technical Specifications

- ITEM NO. 851 (EXISTING MANHOLE ADJUSTMENT)
 - Payment for manhole adjustment shall include ring and cover replacement, flowable fill backfill and manhole concrete encasement
- ITEM NO. 852 (SANITARY SEWER MANHOLES)
 - Deletes Conshield Biotech Armor as an approved coating material for Sanitary Sewer Manholes
- ITEM NO. 864 (SMALL DIAMETER SANITARY SEWERS)
 - Contractor is responsible for determining if suction or discharge manhole ring and cover has sufficient dimensions to accommodate bypass pumping and shall remove, as necessary.
 - Measurement and payment of bypass pumping to be lump sum per site as shown in bid form.



Special Provisions to the Technical Specifications

- ITEM NO. 1020 (WATER MAIN BREAK, LEAK REPAIRS)
 - Payment for breaks/leaks will not be made to Contractor as a result of Contractor's construction operations.
 - Cutting and replacing pavements (any type), curbs, sidewalks and sodding shall be considered subsidiary to Item 1020 and no direct payment will be made.
 - Payment shall include all pipe appurtenances required as well as protective coating materials for bolts, nuts, ferrous surfaces, polyethylene sleeve where required and any pumping of water, necessary hauling and disposition of surplus excavated material.



Special Provisions to the Technical Specifications

- ITEM NO. SP-1109 (SANITARY SEWER LATERAL AND RECONNECTIONS)
 - Reconnection by Excavation method will be conducted by removing a portion of sewer main to expose the liner pipe, cutting a hole in the liner pipe to install the Inserta-Tee.
 - Removing and replacing any cracked, offset, or leaking service line for up to 5 feet, measuring horizontally from the center of the new main or liner.
 - Lateral connection shall be encased in cement stabilized sand and shall be tested before backfilling
- ITEM 530 (BARRICADES, SIGNS, AND TRAFFIC HANDLING)
 - Contractor shall provide at least fourteen (14) days advance notification to impacted residents and businesses by distributing door hangers.
- ITEM 540 (TEMPORARY EROSION, SEDIMENTATION AND WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION CONTROL)
 - Measurement and payment for this item to be lump sum.



Special Specifications

TREE MITIGATION/PROTECTION PLANS

- Contractor shall protect trees and landscape, and perform necessary tree pruning, soil amending and fertilization in accordance with CoSA items 801 and 802 and Tre Preservation Details Plan
- All tree removals shall be in accordance with Supplemental Specification I Tree Removal
- All new tree and shrub planting shall be in accordance with CoSA Item 804


TREE PERMIT

- Sites 207, 310.2, 310.3 and 324 will involve tree removal which may require additional permitting coordination with the CoSA Tree Department.
- Contractor to adhere to the City of San Antonio Tree Ordinance, May 6, 2010 and notify the Engineer
 if any Significant or Heritage Trees are required to be removed prior to construction to allow
 adequate time for any necessary coordination and/or additional permitting requirements.
