Specifications For Work Gloves, Rubber-Coated, Knit-Lined

Revised March 4, 2013

1. SCOPE

This specification covers personal protective glove wear to be worn by San Antonio Water System (SAWS) employees for use when hands may be immersed in water or sewage and are doing lifting or pulling activities, or may be scratched or bumped during mechanical processes. For use when dexterity is less important and avoiding wet hands is more important. Glove wear shall be offered in a variety of sizes.

2. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Description:

- Gauntlet Style. Glove is made of ultra light weight knit fabric. Dipped in natural latex. The full cotton lining provides comfort and protection against dermatitis while allowing dexterity.
- Materials: Liner- 100% Rib Knit cotton, 130+/-10 grams per square meter.
- Coating - Single Dip coated, pure gum natural rubber latex, compounded with chemicals selected for low toxicity.
- Finish - Surface etched to enhance wet grip, no additional material used.
- Sizes: Small to 2XL (7 to 11).
- The length of the glove is no less than 11”.
