Specifications For Leather Work Gloves

Revised March 4, 2013

1. **SCOPE**

This specification covers personal protective glove wear to be worn by San Antonio Water System (SAWS) employees for use when hands may be scratched or bumped during mechanical processes, or to prevent slippage during lifting or pulling. Not for use when liquid splashing or immersion is likely. Glove wear shall be offered in a variety of sizes.

2. **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

Description:

- A leather work glove made of top side hide grain cowhide leather (standard grain C-grade, or better).
- Unlined, Elastic back and Keystone Thumb.
- Sizes: Small to 3X-Large (7-12)
- Pigskin will not be accepted. No split colors
