**Specifications For Work Gloves, Mechanic's Style**

1. **SCOPE**

This specification covers personal protective glove wear to be worn by San Antonio Water System (SAWS) employees for use when hands may be scratched or bumped during mechanical processes, or during lifting or pulling. For use when liquid splashing or immersion is a possibility, and when dexterity is important. Glove wear shall be offered in a variety of sizes.

2. **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

ANSI /ISEA 105-2005 rating of 2 or better on cut resistance, or CE/EN 388 rating of 3 or better for cut resistance.

**Description:** A general purpose glove, made of Dyneema/Lycra with gray polyurethane palm coating. It provides good wet and dry grip. Ergonomically designed forms provide naturally curved, relaxed fit, to reduce hand fatigue. Designed for handling sharp, small parts, plus glass and metal (even when slightly oily).

- 9.5-inch length, with elasticized knit wrist
- Sizes 6-11 (XS – XXL)
