Specifications For Work Gloves, Needlestick-Resistant

1. **SCOPE**

This specification covers personal protective glove wear to be worn by San Antonio Water System (SAWS) employees for use when hands may be punctured or cut by sharp objects during cleaning of mechanical processes, such as those associated with wastewater pumps. Glove wear shall be offered in a variety of sizes.

2. **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

ANSI /ISEA 105-2005 rating of 5 or better on cut resistance, and CE/EN 388 score of 4544 or better, plus needle-stick resistance of at least 250 grams, using ASTM F2878.

Description: A glove designed to resist needlesticks, which is also highly resistant to cuts, abrasion, and punctures.

- Protects the full palm, fingertips, and between the fingers on the palm side.
- Launderable.
- Sizes 7-10 (S – XL)
