




Water Rate Structures Tiered (Most Frequent) Fixed meter charge plus volumetric charges with rates that increase at higher levels of consumption Base Excess Fixed meter charge plus volumetric charges with rates that increase at higher levels of consumption relative to established baseline consumption Residential Base Excess Rates: El Paso and Lubbock Commercial Base Excess Rates: El Paso, Dallas and SAWS Fixed Block Rate (Houston only) No fixed meter charge; all residential consumption charged single volumetric rate that varies at different consumption levels (or blocks) and size of water meter







Sewer Rate Structures (Res. & Comm.) No Minimum Base Usage Charge; Single Volumetric Rate (Most Frequent) Residential Usage Based on Winter Average Minimum Base Consumption Charge Plus Single Volumetric Rate for Usage over Base SAWS, Plano, El Paso and Corpus Christi Residential Usage Based on Winter Average Fixed Block Rate (Houston only) No fixed meter charge; all sewer usage charged single volumetric rate that varies at different usage levels (or blocks) and size of water meter No Winter Average for Residential Usage; Based on Water Consumption

Sewer Rate Structures (cont.) Residential monthly maximum number of gallons charged for sewer: Dallas – 40,000 gallons Fort Worth – 22,443 gallons Corpus Christi – 25,000 gallons El Paso charges sewer for only 90% of Winter Average water consumption
